From Pastor Ralph's Desk:

It's Going To Be Okay

(Rev. 1:9-20)

Intro: Things in our world right now don't feel okay at all. All the recent terrorist activity in Europe is right now knocking at our door. Also, with our country's strong stance against radical Islam, will possibly intensify their attacks around the world.

Things in our world right now don't feel okay because our nation is divided in Washington DC like we have not seen in a long time. Nothing is getting done because there is so much corruption in Washington and because it seems that they are more concerned about looking out for themselves than for the good of the country. And when someone does try to get things done for the good of the country, they usually fall under attack from the media or opposing political leaders.

Things in our world right now do not feel okay because of the general day to day battles that we face in general.

However, the greatest reason that it doesn't feel okay in the world right now is because our world is pushing God out of everything and the world that we once knew has become something that we thought we would never see. So, would someone please tell us that everything is going to be okay?

Well, the good news is that in our current text, we get that absolute assurance from our Lord Jesus Christ that indeed and in fact everything is going to be okay. The Apostle John is exiled on an isolated island for preaching the Word of God and lifting up Jesus. He is way up in age, possibly close to a hundred. I am sure that for him that it was at this time that our Lord showed up and assured him that it was all going to be okay and He answered it in a loud and bold way. So, it is today that He is saying to us it is all going to be okay.

I. First, it is going to be okay because Jesus knows exactly where we are and what is going on with us, vs 9-11.

These verses open with a description of the suffering that John was facing for his service to the Lord Jesus Christ. It was at

this moment as John was thinking about his suffering that the Lord let John know that He knew right where he was at and what was going on with him. It was no surprise to the Lord that John was exiled on a desolate island for preaching the Gospel. He knew exactly where John was at and what was happening to him and that is why He was able to show up right where he was and say and do what let John know that everything will be okay. So, for John to know that the Lord knows where he was and what was happening to him, let him know that it is going to be okay.

Just as with John, the Lord is saying to us as well, I know where you are and what is going on with you and just because he knows, gives us great encouragement that it is going to be okay.

II. Second, it is going to be okay because Jesus speaks to us, vs 9-10.

In verse ten, we are told that John heard a loud voice and we know that the loud voice was the voice of our blessed Lord Jesus Christ. So, clearly not only did the Lord make His presence known but He also spoke directly to John. For John to hear the voice of our Lord gave him reassuring encouragement that everything was going to be okay.

Whenever we need to hear it is going to be okay, we just need to dive into God's Word and let Him speak to us from there. When we are in God's Word, it allows the Holy Spirit to bring to our hearts and our minds what God has said in His Word to us and that is the same as the Lord speaking directly to us. This will give us blessed assurance that everything is going to be okay.

When I was a child and something brought fear into my life, all I needed to hear was the encouraging voice of my mom or dad to relieve the fear. Well, if our parents or other folks voices can help, how much more will hearing the voice of the King of kings and Lord of lords assure us it is all going to be okay.

III. Third, it is going to be okay because Jesus lets us know just who He is, vs 12-18.

Jesus allowed John to see Him for just who He really is. In the past, John saw Jesus as a man. He saw Him when He dwelt in human flesh with human blood flowing through His veins. He saw Him when He grew tired and required rest. He saw Him when He was hungry and thirsty. He saw Him when it was necessary for Him to have to walk to get to where He was going. He also saw Him when He was taken by wicked men and was cruelly beaten and crucified, and even though John saw Him in His resurrection glory, it had been many years since he physically had seen Jesus in this way.

Now, However, Jesus comes to John and allows him to see Him in all of His glory He now sees Him not as the suffering servant that he saw Jesus to be many years ago. Rather, now He sees the victorious risen and exalted King of kings and Lord of lords. He sees Him as the one who was dead but now He is alive forevermore.

When we take our eyes off of our weaknesses and our problems and instead focus upon the glorified, risen, exalted Lord Jesus Christ and see Him for who He is, we will be able to say everything is going to be okay. Particularly

when we understand that it is He who holds the leys of death and Hades. Keys represent authority. Jesus is telling John and us that with these keys He has all authority. Oh, Child of God, it is all going to be okay.

IV. Fourth, it is going to be okay because the past, the present, and the future are in the hands of Jesus, vs 19.

John told Jesus to write what he had seen (the past), what was now (the present), and what will take place (the future). What Jesus is saying to John is I want you to write about what you experienced in the past because I was there with you. I want you to write about what is happening now because I am here now. Finally, I want you to write about the future because I will be there with you as well. As a matter of fact, the past, present and future are all about Me and because you have just seen who I am, you can count on it that everything is going to be okay for I have always been in the past and will always be in the present and will forever be in the future. I have got the whole thing in my hand.

Our family, friends and community can offer us help and encouragement for only so long because of their human limitations and therefore we can count on Him yesterday, today and forever.

V. Fifth and let me say finally, that everything is going to be okay because of Jesus' activity with the church, vs 20.

In previous verses, John saw in the vision that Jesus was giving to him a picture of seven golden lamp stands and seven stars in Jesus' right hand. In our present verse, Jesus reveals to John what the lamp stands and stars refer to. The lamp stands are the churches and the stars are the angels or messengers of the churches.

Now, this answer that Jesus gives John lets us indeed know that everything is going to be okay. For Jesus lets us know what His activities are with the church. The first activity is that He holds the messengers of the church in His right hand. Now, most scholars believe that this is a reference to the leaders and pastors of the church. This lets us know that everything is going to be okay because the pastors and leaders in the churches are being guided along by the Lord Himself.

The second activity that we see Jesus doing is standing in the midst of the churches. Because He is in their midst we know that everything is going to be okay because He is there to watch over us, guide us, empower us and just be there. Oh, praise God, it is all going to be okay.
