# From Pastor Ralph's Desk: The Total Coverage of God's Love

(Psalm 136: 1-26)

Today I want us to examine a chapter that mentions the word "love" 26 times. As a matter of fact, every verse in the chapter has it. So, obviously, love is the primary theme of the chapter. However, some might challenge that because they see thanksgiving as the real thrust of the chapter. But the reason why we are called to give thanks is because of the everlasting, enduring love that God has for His people.

Now, what we actually discover in the chapter is a description of the enduring love that God has for the nation of Israel. It is a picture or a snapshot of a love that God has had for Israel since before their beginning and will endure throughout their eternity. One might say, then does it not include the people of God in the New Testament called the Church? Well, the answer to that is a definite, yes. For all the principles found in this chapter of the love of God can all be found in the New Testament as well.

There are many insurance companies that claim that they can cover you from the womb to the tomb. However, what we will discover from this chapter is that God's love for His people covers them from before they were conceived and it covers them for the rest of their eternity. So, if I want true, complete and total coverage bank it on the love of God and by the way it is a whole lot cheaper.

## I. First, the total coverage of God's love is seen in the person who is love vs. 1-3.

Now, the total coverage of God's love for us began long before anyone of us living were ever conceived. Also, His love for us began long before He created the nation of Israel and long before He created Adam and Eve. These first three verses are a reminder from the psalmist that the nation of Israel should give thanks to the goodness of their God who by the way is the very God of gods and Lord of lords. When you notice in the previous chapter that the psalmist declared

That all other nations worshipped idols and no the true God and yu see that when in verses two and three, it says God of gods and Lord of lords each of the second groups are spelled with a small letter then you realize the psalmist is saying that God alone is God.

Also, the psalmist is saying that God is good because God has always had enduring love. That is why He is good. He has had enduring love because He is God and as being God, He is love. John tells us in his writings that whoever loves has been born of God because God is love. We love Him because He first loved us. So, why did He first love us? Well, because His love is enduring and it is always been with Him. He began loving us in His eternal past. So, we have never "not" been loved. Praise the Lord.

## II. Second, the total coverage of God's love is seen in the products made by His love vs. 4-9.

Tragically, we have lost the wonder of our creation because we have become so secular minded about the creation. This causes us to examine things in almost a purposeless way. A world that has just come about by mere chance and accident. There is nothing exciting about that. I am so glad, praise God, to be a Child of God which allows me to see the wonder of our great creation that's been created with power and majesty and purpose and complexity that can only be contributed to our eternal God. No wonder it never cease to amaze us.

Now, the reason why it is so filled with wonder beyond our imagination is because God created it with His enduring love. This enduring love of His led Him to create human beings in His image so that we could enjoy a relationship with Him and enjoy this wonderful world that He placed us in.

It is true that sin has scared it all up but God's love in His creation still shines trough magnificently. So, if you want to see the wonder of our creation, then see it through the eyes of our Creator who did it through His everlasting love.

## III. Third, the total coverage of God's love is seen by the people saved by His love vs. 10-20.

In these set of verses, what we see is God's deliverance of the nation of Israel out of Egyptian bondage. They had been in this bondage and slavery for 400 years. During all this time they had never had the means or capability of delivering themselves out of their horrible circumstances. Of course, what finally made the difference was the intervention of Almighty God. Through His infinite wisdom, power and grace, He mightily delivered the entire nation

out of slavery into being a free nation.

The Psalmist goes on to tell us that not only did God set them free from the Egyptians and did so powerfully but He also set them free from every powerful enemy that they encountered on their journey to the Promise Land and in the Promise Land.

God, too, has powerfully and graciously set us free from all the enemies that held us in bondage. Enemies that were more powerful than we ourselves but never more powerful than our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. By His incarnation into our world, He intervenes on our behalf all the way to the cross and then up out of the grave and finally back to glory where He came from to begin with where He continuously is praying to the Father on our behalf. Therefore, the enemies of sin, Satan, death, hell and the grave have been conquered and through repentance and faith in Christ, we've been graciously set free.

Now, of course once again, we must remember that all of this happened because of God's unending love for us. Oh, blessed be our loving Lord and Savior who came to set us free. Oh, what love He has for us.

## Fourth, the total coverage of God's love is seen in the Promise Land provided by His love vs. 21-22.

In these verses, we discover that God took the land of their enemies that they defeated by His power and gave it to them as their own land. It was the land that He promised to them centuries ago and is now bringing that promise to fruition. Out of His enduring love, He promised this land for them. Well, out of His enduig love for us He's also providing for us, the Church, a promise land that He is now preparing for us. John 14:1-6, Jesus tells us about this promis land He's preparing for us and He also tells about how we get there and that is through Him. Oh, what love Jesus has for us that He is preparing an eternal promise land where we can dwell with Him forever. My prayer is that you have placed your trust in Him for your eternal salvation.

## V. Fifth, the total coverage of God's love is seen in the provisions provided by His love vs. 23-25.

In these verses, the Psalmist reminds us that when Israel couldn't take are of themselves while, as he says, in a low estate, God came along and freed them from their enemies and then provided their necessities. Well, it is no different today. For God is saving through Jesus Christ, His people today setting them free from their enemies then providing for their eternal necessities. Listen to those amazing verses found in Romans 8:31-32. "What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If god is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?"

With His enduring love, He eternally provides the provisions that we need and will need.

Conclusion: Verse twenty six wraps yup the complete picture of God's total coverage of love. We started in the first set of verses of God's enduring love for us before we were even create because He is the Eternal God who is eternal love. Then it moved to His enduring love for us in His creation of us and our world. The coverage then moves to His enduing love saving us from our enemies by His very own intervention on our behalf. But His enduring love didn't stop there. No, it went on to give us a promise land and give us the provisions we need. It then concludes with giving thanks to the God of Heaven. So, we are reminded when we are no longer here on earth experiencing His love, we will eternally be doing so with Him in Heaven. We are covered absolutely 100% eternally by His love now and forever. Praise the Lord.

Are you covered by this eternal love policy? If you have repented of your sins and placed your trust in Jesus Christ for your salvation, then you are covered.




