

From Fastor Ralph's Desk: We Are Blessed Beyond Measure

(*Ephesians 1:1-14*)

Intro: In verse three of our text, it begins with depending on your translation, either "Praise or Blessed be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ..." Now that first word either Praise or Blessed in the Greed language means to speak well of. So, the verse is telling us that as God's people we are to speak well of God directly to Him and speak well about Him to others. So the question may arise why should we speak well about Him to others?

The answer to those questions is found in theses verses as well. The general answer is that we are to bless God because He has blessed us. Possibly no greater set of verses in the New Testament describes God's blessings to His people more than this chapter does. These blessings of God to His people are amazing beyond measure. As we said the Greek word for blessing to God means to speak well of. However, the word for blessing which God directs toward us means to benefit. So when God blessed us and blesses us, He is benefitting our lives. This is why I have titled my message, "We Are Blessed Beyond Measure." So, let's examine these blessings so that we may in turn bless and praise our blessed Lord. We will begin today looking at a couple of those blessings. I. First, we are blessed beyond measure because of the persons involved in our blessings, vs 3, 13-14. If we fail to understand this point, then we will most likely fail to give our God the praise He is worthy of on the other points. For this is where the blessings truly come from and this is what makes them so amazing and so beyond measure. That its from God the Father through His Son Jesus and sealed by the Holy Spirit.

So, stop and think about it my friends. It is not just another human being or another great person or some celebrity that is blessing you. Rather, it is the God of the universe, it is the God of all ages that is reaching down to you. This is so amazing that the perfect, holy and eternal God who has no flaws has chosen to bless and benefit the very ones who whose to ignore His laws, His will and His ways. As the result of that, the Bible says we became ungodly and separated from Him and even described as His enemies. Yet even than God chose to bless us and God the Father chose to bless us through His glorious Son whom He loved and loves. He chose that His Son would deliver directly to us by stepping into humanity leading all the way to Calvary then conquering the grave. He imparted to us our eternal salvation. The Savior blessing the sinner. The Holy blessing the unholy. The Perfect blessing the imperfect. The Righteous One blessing the unrighteous. As so famously stated in Romans 5:6-8, "You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for a good person someone mi8ght possibly dare to die. But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

If a famous person gives you a gift through some other person as happened to me once when Ned Jarrett and Dale Jarrett and Jason Jarrett all signed a hat for me and sent it to me through another individual. I was on top of the world. I showed that hat to may folks and told many more about it. However, they are just men. They may be famous race care drivers but they like me are just men. Oh, praise the Lord. However, when God blessed me it was not just a great person but it was through His Holy Son He came to me. Let us grasp that God is even more worthy for us to bless Him because He has blessed us. This is worthy of speaking well of.

II. Second, we are blessed beyond measure because of the period we received our blessing, vs 3-4. In verse three Paul tell us these words to describe the period or timing of our blessing from God, "Who has blessed us..." Now this is a past tense phrase. In other words this phrase is letting us know that the blessings of God to us have already taken place. So the question is just how far back was it that God poured our His blessings upon us? The answer to that question is found in verse four where it says, "He chose us in Him before the creation of the world..." The answer to the question just how far back did He give our blessing is eternity past.

This means before the first human beings breathed their first breath and knowing that before they were created, they would sin against Him. God still chose that He would give His Son to die to save us. He chose that in His Son our salvation would be complete and eternal for before we even came into existence.

Now the blessings He determined were not fleshed our of course until creation came into existence and Jesus came to us over 2,000 years ago. But in God's heart, mind and will, they were already done, accomplished and poured out in eternity past. That is how much God loves us. Oh what a Savior.

Now we have not received all the blessings yet but they are already determined and granted to us. Much like a will when they are written. The person making the will determines who will get what. However, what the will specifies, will not be metered out until the time the will indicates. However, it is already a done deal. It is just a matter of time before what is determined will be granted.

Let me say, you do not have to beg for God's blessings. They are yours to be appropriated by faith.

Thank you Lord that your blessings are from eternity past. For this we have blessed your name forever.
