

From Fastor Ralph's Desk: The Power of the Name of Jesus

(Acts 4)

Intro: A very important question to ask right now is why is it that most of our press and media and many of our government officials across our land are being so helpful and even encouraging to the very religion that has carried out the majority of the terroristic activities in the world for the last several years. Even in our own country for the last 15 years they have killed thousands on our own shores from 9-11 to the Boston marathon bombing also Fort Hood shooting, the California shooting and finally the Orlando shooting.

Also, not only have they carried out the terroristic activity but their own beliefs caused them to treat women and children as second class citizens. It also teaches them that they can kill anyone who disagrees with their faith, their teachings, even tell them that it is okay to lie if it will promote their religions.

Now the Christian faith is not carrying our terrorism. It does not make women and children second class citizens. It does not kill those who disagree with it and doesn't teach you to lie in order to promote your faith. Yet, the Christian faith is under constant attack and threat from the very ones that promote the Muslim religion which stands for everything they don't agree with except for the lying part.

Now the question again is why, why promote a religion that you so sharply disagree with in so many ways, then attack the Christian faith that is nothing like the other religions?

Jesus gives us that answer and that answer is in a name, His name, the name of Jesus. Listen to His words, "Then he said to them: "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be great earthquakes, famines and pestilences in various places, and fearful events and great signs from heaven." "But before all this, they will seize you and persecute you. They will hand you over to synagogues and put you in prison, and you will be brought before kings and governors, and all on account of my name. And so you will bear testimony to me. But make up your mind not to worry beforehand how you will defend yourselves. For I will give you words and wisdom that none of your adversaries will be able to resist or contradict." So, Jesus is clear that it is all on account of My name. this same name that brings on our threats and attacks is also the same name that gives us complete victory over all. There is absolute power in the name of Jesus, and I want us to take a look at the power of that name.

I. First of all, the power of His name is the power to heal, vs 6-10; 3:16. chapter three is the story of how Peter and John healed a man at the temple who was born lame. This man was brought to the temple each day to beg for alms. Peter and John offered this man something far greater than alms. Rather they offered him total and complete healing, and in the name of Jesus this man got up and began jumping, leaping and running. Peter and John took absolutely no credit for his healing. They rather gave all the credit to the name of Jesus.

Now I want you to understand that the Lord does not always choose to heal us. Paul prayed for healing three times yet, God answered each time that His grace was sufficient. Yet that ability to deal with and face your sickness through His grace in a way is a form of healing. It is a healing of moving on in spite of your sickness.

However, all healing when it happens, comes from the Lord. Whether it is healing seen in a miraculous way or through medical procedures. It all comes from the Lord. Ps. 103: "Praise the LORD, my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name. Praise the LORD, my soul, and forget not all his benefits—who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases" That last verse tells us that we are to Praise the Lord because He heals all of our diseases. Now it is important to notice that He says all. You say however that is not true because you have a disease or you know someone who has or had a disease that He did not heal or has not healed and you prayed for Him to do so.

Well let me answer that by saying it is true He will heal all and I mean all of our diseases. However, what we must remember is that the timing of that healing is always in His hand, and for many of us that timing will not come until we leave this earth. At that moment though the blessed Lord will heal all of His peoples diseases whatever they may be.

My dad suffered with Parkinson's disease for at least 30 years. When I was a young boy, my dad was six foot four and weighed about 230 pounds. He was all muscle. When he died he had shriveled up and he

weighed only 90 pounds. Every bit of that muscle and stamina was totally gone. As a young Christian I prayed for my dad's healing every night. One night God spoke to me in an audible voice, one of the few times and told me that He would answer my prayer but I had to leave the timing up to Him. He let me know that death for the Child of God was the ultimate healing. So yes, Child of God, if He doesn't heal you here and now by His power He will heal you then and there forever. Blessed be the name of the Lord.

Let me point out one more Scripture and that the Old Testament prophecy of Jesus' death on the cross for us. In this prophecy we are reminded that in securing our redemption for us at the cross and through His death, He also secured our healing for us. Now I believe it is referring primarily about spiritual healing, but if He had not done this for us we should not be experiencing any kind of healing. Praise our blessed Lord and Savior Jesus Christ who brought us healing in redemption, Isaiah 53:4-5, "Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed."

II. Second of all the power of His name is the power to do good, vs 9.

Peter filled with the Holy Spirit threw a curve ball right at the very ones who arrested them by saying basically you want to know who did this act of kindness and goodness to this man that was lame? Well he said it wasn't us, it was doe in the power of and authority of Jesus' name. Acts 10:38 says Peter was preaching to the family and friends of a gentile named Cornelius. He was telling them about Jesus and in this verse he tells them how in the power of the Holy Spirit, Jesus went about doing acts of kindness and goodness.

Also, James 1:17 says "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows."

So, let us remember that God has called His people to go about doing acts of kindness and goodness, but we must remember that it only can be done in and through the power of His name. So, will it be said of us as individuals and together as a church that in the power of His name we did acts of goodness and kindness for His power is released to us to be His agents of goodness and kindness.
