From Pastor Ralph's Desk:

#### **The Revelation Salutation** (Part II)

(Revelation 1:4-8)

Intro: Last week we began looking at the Book's salutation. Instead of being only two words long like in most letters, this one is five verses long. It is a very powerful salutation which leads us on a very fast look at the whole of the Book.

The first point that we looked at last week was those addressed in the Revelation Salutation. There were seven specific churches addressed. Now we will move on to the next point of the salutation.

## II. Second, let us notice those attributed with giving the Revelation Salutation. (vs. 4-5)

Of course, John acknowledges that he is the one who is writing the letter. However, he is quick to point out that though he is writing the salutation, what it contains did not originate with him. Rather, he attributed the content of the salutation, as well as the whole Book, came from God Himself. So, when John writes the salutation, he is doing so on God's behalf.

Now, as he attributes the words of the salutation to God, he does so with a two-fold point of view. So, we will start looking at that two-fold point of view.

## A. First, those attributed with giving the Revelation Salutation is one person.

That one person is the Blessed Triune God. Or as most people refer to Him as the Holy Trinity. One God made up of three persons.

Now, of course, whenever in the Word of God, one person of the Blessed Trinity speaks to anyone, then they all do because of their connection together. But, what I want us to notice is that on this occasion, God revealed Himself in all three person together which is not found often in the Scriptures.

Now I believe what God was doing was making sure that the seven churches being addressed and ultimately all of us, would understand just how important we mean to all three persons of the Holy Trinity. Also, I believe that all three persons of the Holy Trinity are addressing us as the one true God so that we would understand just how important this Book is to us, and how important we should heed its' teaching.

I know that the teaching of the Trinity is not easy to grasp, but it is powerful. I like what one author said about our experience he had with his son a number of years back. Here is what he said. "Several years ago, my oldest child, Joshua, and I were spending time together. While I was sitting in my glider, Joshua went over to his toy bag and grabbed a tennis ball and brought it to me. He then went back to the bag and got a small nerf ball and returned to me with it. Lastly, he went and picked up a mini basketball. He then tried to take all three of them out of my lap and hold them, but no matter how hard he tried, he just couldn't hold all three. He wasn't capable of handling all three because he wasn't big enough. The

Trinity is just like that—three-in-one is just more than our small, finite minds can grasp. The Trinity is above reason. It cannot be explained by logic; it is a teaching that we must grasp only by faith. And that is okay! Let us look into the Godhead."

Let the church rejoice that the Holy Trinity has reached out to us, the churches, with His grace and peace and also with knowledge, wisdom and instruction found in this Book. When rarely will we be addressed by a famous person, here we are addressed by Holy god. Oh, praise be to our awesome God.

## B. Second, those attributed with giving the Revelation Salutation is three persons. (vs. 4-5)

Of course, we all know what I am referring to here are the actual three distinct persons that make up the Holy Trinity. There is but one God but He is made up of three real distinct persons, whom we all know to be the Father, the Son and Holy Spirit. Today, we will only look at the first person mentioned of the three, which is the Father.

Now, the term Father, or Heavenly Father, is not mentioned in the two verses that we are focused upon. However, the Spirit is mentioned and the Son is mentioned. So, the first person who is referred to as, the One, "Who is, and who was and who is to com," obviously is referring to the Heavenly Father. Of course, I must say that what is true of each applies to them all.

Now, this phrase, "...from Him who is, and who was, and who is to come..." is not found exactly like this no where else except in the Book of Revelation. However, the teaching of it, is amply taught throughout the Word of God.

Now, there are at least two things this phrase refers to. First, it is referring to the fact that our Blessed God is eternal. There has never been a time which there's not been God. He dwells in eternity with no beginning and no ending.

As Christians, we often either just live in the past or just in the moment. This determines how we respond to things and how we act and think. Logically, sometimes this becomes a big hindrance to our ability to move forward in our service to our Blessed Lord. If we could just grasp the fact that our God is the God of our past, present and future, then, we could move forward in victory because we know He has already got it all worked out. Out present will all be wrapped up in our future because God is the God of it all.

Second, this phrase means not only that God is eternal but ia also means He is Almighty. Verse eight says, "I am Alpha and Omega," says the Lord God, "Who is and Who was and Who is to come, the Almighty." Because God is eternal, He is Almighty. Therefore, because He is Almighty, He will be able to bring all things to the final and glorious conclusion that He prophesies in this Book. Also, because He is Almighty in all times, He has all the power He needs to lead us to be able to fulfill His purpose for us in the present and the future.

Let God's people understand that because God is eternal and Almighty, we are more than conquerors and we must stand up and take notice of His address to us for we stand in His Almighty, Eternal Presence.

Blessed be our glorious Lord.

Tithely does not charge any setup or monthly fees. Tithely simply deducts a transaction fee when a donation is made.

Credit/Debit Card:  $2.9\% + 30\phi$  per transaction ACH/Bank:  $1\% + 30\phi$  | AMEX:  $3.5\% + 30\phi$ 

In other words, for a credit card donation of \$100.00, Tithely would deduct \$3.20, and the church would deposit the remaining \$96.80.

Donors have the option to cover these card fees themselves if they choose.
