From Pastor Ralph's Desk:

The Revelation Salutation (Part III)

(Revelation 1:4-8)

Intro: This is the third message from the Salutation verses. The first message we examined those who are addressed in the salutation. We discover that it was seven particular churches which are mentioned in verse eleven and chapter two and three.

The second message is dealing with those attributed with giving the salutation. First, John attributed the salutation to one person and then secondly to three persons. So, obviously John is telling us that it was God as one and God as three. Otherwise known as the Holy Trinity. We examined it from the point of God as one and now we are examining each of the three that make up the one. Last week we looked at the first mentioned and that would be the Father. He is described as the One who is; Who was; and Who is to come. This lets us know that our Blessed God is both Eternal and Almighty. So, today, we will look at the other two persons. Of course, we're referring to the Son and the Spirit.

II. Now, we are noticing the second person attributed with the Revelation Salutation of the three persons mentioned.

John mentioned before He mentions the Son, the Spirit first. He describes the Holy Spirit not as the Holy Spirit but rather as "The Seven Spirits before His throne." the Holy Spirit is described this way at least three other times in the book. So, the questions is how do we know that the Seven Spirits before His throne is the Holy Spirit?

Well, this answer is found first of all with the number seven. Seven is the Biblical number for perfection and completion. The Holy Spirit is both perfect and complete. Also, since He is before the throne, He has to be the Spirit of God. Another reason I believe it refers to the Holy Spirit is because of the sevenfold ministry of the Spirit of God. The Book of Isaiah describes these sevenfold ministries of the Spirit, "the Spirit of the LORD will rest on him—the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the LORD—" (Is. 11:2) From this verse we find out that the Holy Spirit {1st} is the Spirit of the LORD {2nd} He is the Spirit of wisdom {3rd} He is the Spirit of understanding {4th} He is the Spirit of knowledge and finally {7th} He is the Spirit of the Fear of the LORD.

So, the blessing of being addressed by the Holy Spirit is knowing that the Spirit of God being both perfect and complete as well as having His sevenfold ministry, then, we know that because He indwells in His people, we can be and do all that He wants us to do. Praise His Holy name.

II. B.3. Now, we are noticing the third person attributed with the Revelation Salutation of the three persons mentioned.

So, if we are going to use the process of elimination, then we would know that the one person left is the Son of God. However, we

don't have to use the process of elimination because John clearly shows us that it is Jesus Christ the glorious Son of God. John gives us three descriptions of Jesus Christ. First, John describes Him as the Faithful Witness. As the Faithful Witness, Jesus shared the truth. He displayed the truth. He was and is the Truth. He didn't come to make suggestions. Rather, He came with the truth, "You are a king, then!" said Pilate. Jesus answered, "You say that I am a king. In fact, the reason I was born and come into the world is to testify to the truth. Everyone on the side of truth listens to me." (John 18:37) therefore, this means that the church can speak with boldness for Jesus has been the Faithful Witness to us.

Second, John tells us that He is "the Firstborn from the dead." Paul the Apostle also tells us this same truth in the Book of Colossians, (Col 1:18). First, this verse means that no one had risen in the manner that Christ had risen. He was the first to resurrect in a glorified body that would never taste death again. All other persons resurrected in a body eventually died again.

Second, this phrase is referring not primarily to chronological order, but rather to rank and position. As one Biblical scholar said, "It simply means that of all those who rise from the dead, He retains supremacy in rank and dignity over all. He was raised never to die again and exalted to a position above all, awaiting the day when every knee shall bow and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father (Phil. 2:8-11). Oh, Child of God, because of His rank, we have all power to be successful in the work and will of God, Amen.

The third way John describes Jesus is that He is, "The ruler of the King of the earth." Christians since their beginning have had to face up to wicked leaders and rulers of men who have done their best to wipe out the people of God and until Jesus returns, they will continue to try. But God's people need not fret over these wicked rulers because Jesus Christ is the King of kings and Lord of lords.

Their days of terror of God's people will one day cease when Jesus returns to set on the throne to never be dethroned because He is the eternal Son of God. Two great chapters I would encourage you to dive into that nails this point is Psalms 2 and 24. through Christ and with Christ, we will reign victorious. Oh, blessed be His Holy name.

Concl. So, let us rejoice exuberantly that the One who has been addressed is our blessed God in all of His personhood as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. From this we know that we win. Thank you Lord.
