### From Tastor Ralph's Desk:

## The Voice, The Vision, The Victory (Part VI)

#### Revelation 1:9-20

Intro: Today we are examining the third message on the victory that belongs to the church. We've already looked at four reasons why the church has victory. Victory belongs to the church first because of the priority given to the church. Second, victory belongs to the church because of the place where we find the church. Third, victory belongs to the church because of how precious is the church. Fourth, we noticed last week that victory belongs to the church because of the prayers being lifted up for the church.

Now, it is extremely important that we always remember that the only reason why victory belongs to us is because it belongs to Christ Jesus our Lord. If He did not have victory we wouldn't have victory. Our victory is all wrapped up in who Christ is; what He's done and what He's going to do. His victory is ours and this vision that John received of our glorious Lord revealed to us His victory and thus ours.

#### <u>E. fifth, let us notice that victory belongs to the church because of</u> the proclamations given to the church.

Last week we notice that in the vision John had of Jesus he saw that Jesus was wearing a robe all the way down to His feet and a golden sash around that robe. Now, in the Old Testament, there were primarily three persons who wore a robe like this: a priest, a prophet and a king. Jesus has become all of these persons for us. He is our great high priest and as priest He intercedes or prays to the Father on our behalf.

Now today, we are going to look at the aspect of Jesus as our permanent prophet. The primary responsibility of a prophet is to reveal the Word of God to the people. God would speak directly to the prophet and he would then go to the people and say to them thus says the Lord.

When Jesus walked on the earth, He encountered a Samaritan woman whom He revealed everything about her to her without ever having met her before. She then made this observation about Jesus, "Sir, the woman said, I can see that you are a prophet." How right she was. The bible teaches us that Moses was a great prophet. It also teaches us that another great prophet would rise up like Moses from among the people of Israel. (Deut. 18:15-18). Well Luke in the Book of Acts lets us know that this prophet is, of course, none other thatn Jesus. He also tells us that because Jesus is this prophet, we must listen to Him like no one else. To not listen would be totally detrimental to you. (Acts 3:22-23).

Now, the writer of Hebrews lets us know that Jesus is greater than all the prophets. He is the supreme prophet and He is the prophet that God the Father has finally spoken to us from. "In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days, He has spoken to us by His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, and through who He made the universe." (Heb. 1:1-2")

Also, in John's gospel we find out that Jesus not only has spoken the Word of god to us, but it also lets us know that He is the Living Word of God. So, He has spoken the Word of God verbally to us and He has spoken the Word of God to us by His personhood and by His actions. This is why it is so important that we listen to everything He said and as well listen to everything He did for He is the Word made flesh. His words are final.

In practically all religions of the world their god or gods speak only to the people through special people like a prophet. We thank our Lord that He has spoken to us through the prophets as well. However, there is a clear difference between our Father and their religions and the difference is that not only has God spoken to us through His prophet but through His only begotten Son He has spoken directly to us.

So, let us rejoice that our blessed Lord has given us victory by speaking His Word directly to us. Thank you that as we read the Word of God your blessed Holy Spirit living inside of each of your people reveals Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior to us. Through your Holy Word we can learn of the past, present and future. It tells us what the world cannot see or understand because they are blinded by the devil. But you don't leave us in the dark because your Word lightens our way in a dark, dark world. All we need to do is listen to Him and we will be able to live life to the fullest.

Let us hear Jesus as He says to us, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden light." (Matt. 11:28-30). Let us hear Jesus as He says to us, "I am the way, the truth and the life and no man comes to the Father but by me." (John 14:6).

Let us hear Jesus as He says to us, "... and surely I am with you always, to the very end of the ages." (Matt. 28:20).

Let us hear Jesus as He says, "Father, forgive them for they do not know what they are doing." (Luke 23:34).

Let us hear Jesus as He says, "for God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son." (John 3:16-18).

Now, Child of God, we have victory because Jesus has spoken all things to us that we need to know to live life as god intended and live life eternally. Oh, blessed be our Lord who has left us with an instruction manual which He personally has given directly to us. Are you listening? Are you reading His Word?
