## From Pastor Ralph's Desk: The Voice, The Vision, The Victory (Part VII)

Revelation 1:9-20

Intro: We've examined for several weeks these verses under the heading, The Voice, The Vision, The Victory. It has been an extremely exciting study for me. Today, however, we are going to try and wrap up our study of these verses so that we can move on further into the Book. We will look at the final way in which the church experiences victory through Jesus Christ our Lord. There are no victories apart from Christ but through Christ there are truly more than we can count. So, let us say with the Apostle Paul, "But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." (I Cor. 15:57). So, let us now examine the final reason that victory belongs to the church.

#### <u>G. Seventh, let us notice that victory belongs to the church because</u> of the purity that has and will be given to the church.

The Word of God is quite clear that God has a definite standard for His church. Now this standard is extremely important not only because the Lord tells us what is expected of us but most importantly the same standard that He lays our for the church is the same standard that applies to Himself. In other words, He is telling us to become what He already and has always been. So, you ask what exactly is that standard that belongs to Jesus and is expected of us? Well, the answer is quite clear. The Lord is calling on His church to be pure and holy just as He is.

Listen to just a few of the many verses that reveal this standard that God laid out for us and that He is. I Peter 1:13-16, "therefore prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed. As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance. But just as He who has called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: 'Be holy, because I am holy." Eph. 5:25-27, "Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the Word, and to present her to Himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless."

Heb. 12:4-10, "In your struggle against sin, you have not uet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. And you have forgotten that word of encouragement that addresses you as sons: 'My son, do not make light of the Lord's discipline, and do not lose heart when He rebukes you, because the Lord disciplines those He loves, and He punishes everyone He accepts as a son.' Endure hardship as discipline; God is treating you as sons. For what son is not disciplined by his father? If you are not disciplined and everyone undergoes discipline, then you are illegitimate children and not true sons. Moreover, we have all had human fathers who disciplined us and we respected them for it. How much more should we submit to the Father of our spirits and live. Out father disciplined us for a little while as they thought best; but God disciplines us for our good, that we may share in His holiness."

Now in our present set of verses you may be thinking where does the purity come from that you are referring to? Well, the answer is found again in the Vision of Christ that John experienced. John saw that Christ's head and hair was white like wool and snow. He also saw that Christ's eyes were like blazing fire. We find a similar description of God in the Old Testament. Daniel 7:9-14, "As I looked, thrones were wet in place and the Ancient of Days took His seat. His clothing was white as snow; the hair of His head was white like wool. His throne was flaming with fire, and its wheels were all ablaze. A river of fire was flowing, coming out from before Him. Thousands upon thousands attended Him; ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him. The court was seated and the books were opened. Then I continued to watch because of the boastful words the horn was speaking. I kept looking until the beast was slain and its body destroyed and thrown into the blazing fire. (The other beasts had been stripped of their authority, but were allowed to live for a period of time.) In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence. He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed."

So, the Spirit of God obviously went back to this Old Testament description of God to reveal to John that Jesus Christ is God in all of His power, authority, perfection, purity, holiness and wisdom, which therefore, makes Him alone the only one who is properly qualified to cleanse us; purify us; and discipline us. He does all these things so that like Him we too will become pure and holy as He is.

It is the color of His head and hair and the blazing appearance of His eyes that let us know that He has total and complete wisdom and at the same time the ability to penetrate into our very heart, soul and mind. So, with the wisdom He has and the ability to penetrate our very spirits, gives Him the ability to know our short comings and what He needs to do to move us into the direction of purity. Listen to the words of Dr. Oliver Green. "In verse 14, the Spirit describes the head and the hair of the Son of man. His head and hairs were white like wool, as white as the driven snow. His eyes were as a flame of fire. This person is the 'Ancient of Days' (Dan. 7:9). Divine wisdom in all of its perfection and absolute purity...as pure as God Himself...is set forth and symbolized in the dazzling snow-white hair of the Son of man. His eyes like unto flames of fire...burning, penetrating, searching...exposing all sin and evil, no matter how thoroughly covered it may be. Who could hope to escape the scrutiny of those burning eyes of fire seen by John?"

Also, when we see that, "His voice was like the sound of rushing water," thus indicating that He means business. He is not playing around. He means for us to be holy and pure and that what He is speaking loud about. Also, it means that because of His wisdom to know all things and His ability to penetrate our very being then He speaks to our lives to work on the areas that are sinful and to shore up the areas of righteousness.

Listen, Peter reminds us that, "judgment began with the household of God." (I Pet. 4:17). Also, John tells us that the Lord is going to pull our the pruning knife. Let us rejoice in the great victory. However, you maybe thinking this doesn't sound like victory to me. Oh, but it is because without the purity and holiness we would never be able to see God. So, praise be to our Lord that He is making His church pure and holy.

Concl. In closing, let me say that the church has victory because Jesus will not only judge and purify the church but He will also judge and destroy the wicked. He has in His mouth a double edge sword. They were designed for the purpose of killing the enemy effectively. So, by His very words, He will slay His enemies and have total and complete victory and we will reign with Him. Oh, praise be to our blessed Lord. Along with this, His face shines like the sun in all of its' brilliance because He was, is and will ever be the sovereign, victorious God.
