From Fastor Ralph's Desk:

Jesus' Final Words To Each Of The 7 Churches

(Rev. 2:7,11,17,26-28; 3:5-6,12,21-22))

Intro: As we examined each of the seven churches in Chapter two and three, I specifically skipped over a particular part of each letter. I did this because I wanted to have one final message on this particular part at the conclusion of my sermon on these churches.

Now, the reason why I chose to deal with this particular part at the conclusion of my sermon on these seven churches is twofold. First because of the similarity found in this particular part of each church's letter. Each of the letters in this particular part either begins with or ends with this statement, "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches." Also, each of them talk about, "To him who overcomes..."

The second reason why we are dealing with this particular part at the conclusion is because this particular part is the concluding words of Jesus to each of the churches. Thus this message is about and is actually called Jesus' final words to each of the seven churches.

I. First, Jesus' final words to each of the seven churches contained a plea. Now this is the plea that Jesus gave to each of the churches. "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit ways to the churches." (Rev. 2:7,11,17,26; 3:6,13,22). So Jesus is pleading to all the churches to hear and heed His messages to them.

Now, Jesus is not asking them to hear and heed His message just so that He can show them who the Boss is. Though He is indeed, so to speak, one hundred percent the Boss. However, as our Creator; our Lord; our Savior; and our God, He absolutely loves us, cares for us and wants what is going to totally lead us to experience a close walk with Him and turn us into overcomers, and the only way He cam make that happen is to encourage us to make His words the only words that really matter.

Of course, the question is, where do we hear His words so we can heed them? Well, that question has been answered a thousand times by me to you and it is still the same answer. That answer is to dive into God's Holy Word. This is where we will hear His voice and understand what we need to heed to. Recently and on many other occasions I have had conversations with folks who tell me that the letters in red found in the Bible is what really matters to them. To that statement, I say Amen. They should really matter to us all. Of course, if you don't know what we mean by the red letters of the Bible, let me share with you what they are. They are the actual words that Jesus spoke as He walked and lived in our world until he ascended back to glory. However, I want us to understand that we actually need to see the entire Bible as being letters in red. For the Lord gave us both the Old and New Testaments. It is all meant to be taken seriously from Genesis to Revelation. So, let us hear our Lord's plea and let us move to hear and heed His message, the Word of God.

II. Second, Jesus' final words to each of the seven churches was presented in the plural. We all know that each of these seven churches is a specific church found in a specific location and was written at a specific time period. However, when we come to Jesus' final words to each specific church, He did not say now to the church at such and such place. Rather, He uses the plural form for church which is churches.

What Jesus is saying to each of the churches is that though I have addressed each one of you individually and specifically, I want all of you to hear, comprehend and heed the message that I have given to all of the churches. The message that I have given before the conclusion of each letter and what is in the conclusion itself.

Jesus cares about all of the churches because He cares about each of the churches, and He cares for each of the churches because He cares about all of them. Now, we need to understand that because what He spoke to these specific churches wound up in the Word of God, then we are to understand that those churches that are to hear and heed His words to those churches includes all churches of all time till Jesus comes again. Are we listening?

III. Third, Jesus' final words to each of the seven churches focused upon <u>certain persons.</u> The main question is who are these certain persons I am referring to? Well, Jesus referred to in each final comments this statement, "To him who overcomes..." so, the certain persons I am referring to are according to Jesus are the overcomers.

The second and obvious question is who are these overcomers that Jesus is referring to? Well, first of all let us mention who they are not. They are not some super groups of believers found in each of the congregations who are more faithful than the other believers and are therefore worthy to be given this title.

No, way find the answer as to who they are in another one of the apostle John's writings. "...for everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. Who is it that overcomes the world? Only he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God." (I John5:4-5). We are overcomers by our faith in Jesus Christ who is the ultimate Overcomer. True Believers will persevere in their faith in Jesus throughout their lives because they belong to Him. (Rom. 8:28-39).

IV. Fourth, Jesus' final words to each of the seven churches contained

certain promises. In His final words to each of the churches, He gave certain promises to those who overcame. These promises are not for a select few as we've already discussed in point two. No, these promises are for all true born again Believers.

Here is a brief view of them all, "The privilege of eating from the Tree of Life (2:7); The crown of Life (2:10); protection from second death (2:11); the hidden manna (2:17); a white stone with a new name written on it (2:17); authority to rule the nations (2:26-27); the morning star (2:28); white garments symbolizing purity and holiness (3:5); the honor of having Christ confess their names before God the Father and the holy angels in Heaven (3:5); to be made a pillar in God's temple (3:12); to have written on then the name of God, of the new Jerusalem and of Christ (3:12); and finally the right to sit with Christ on His heavenly throne (3:21).

Now, we could spend a lot of time discussing each of these. However, most evangelical scholars believe that most of these promises are a symbolic way of describing the blessings that God's people are going to enjoy eternally in the presence of our eternal Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Concl. Let us rejoice that our blessed Lord's final words to the churches are words of great promises for the overcomers. Now, the question is have you become an overcomer through faith in Jesus? If not, let this be the day that you repent and place your faith in Jesus Christ our Lord.
