From Pastor Ralph's Desk: John's Trip to Heaven (Part V)

(Rev. 4:1-5)

Intro: When John entered Heaven we noted last week that the first thing that he saw was the throne of Heaven. Therefore, we came to understand that the throne in Heaven is central to all other things. So, our first point was the centrality of the throne of Heaven, and since it is central to Heaven it must also be the focus of our lives as well as here on earth.

The second thing that John saw was not just a throne alone but he also saw someone seated on the throne. Of course, there is no doubt as to who that someone is, it is God Almighty. John gives us a description of how god appeared to Him. The description that he used were two different types of stone. They were a diamond and a ruby. With these descriptions we were able to take a look at the Sovereignty who sits on the throne. Those descriptions remind us that God is our complete Sovereign ruler. What a blessed truth this is. It means that God is able to do everything that He has done, is doing and will do.

Today we will move to the next things that John saw when he got to Heaven. He first saw the centrality of the throne in Heaven and secondly the Sovereignty who sits on the throne of Heaven. Today we will begin to notice the identities he saw around the throne in Heaven.

Now typically identities have to do with identifying human beings. However, John first saw something around the throne before he saw a person around the throne. So, today we will take the time to identify what is around the throne in Heaven first.

III. Third, let us notice that John saw certain identities around the throne of Heaven

A. Today we will attempt to identify what is around the throne of <u>Heaven. (vs. 3).</u> Now John tells us that the first thing he sees encircled around the throne of Heaven is a rainbow that had the appearance of our

emerald. Most likely what he means is that this rainbow instead of displaying the usual color of a rainbow it projected the color of green.

So the question is does this rainbow have any significance or symbolism to it? Well, I believe that it very much does. Today we are going to look at the ways that the rainbow is significant and what it symbolizes as we identify it.

1. First, let us identify the rainbow from the shape of it. Unlike earthly rainbows this rainbow was not broken up by the earth's surface. No the verse says that it completely encircled the throne of Heaven. So what does this shape of this indicate? Well to be honest, this is a very easy answer. A circle has no beginning and no ending. It is a clear picture of eternity. It's a clear picture that the reign of our sovereign God has no beginning and it has no ending. The throne in Heaven is the eternal throne.

The longest reigning earthly monarch with verifiable dates was King Louis XIV of France. His reign lasted 72 years and 110 days. The longest unverifiable reigning monarch on earth was an Egyptian emperor by the name of Pepi II. Supposedly his reign lasted for 94 years. However, we must remember that there are no solid records to verify that. Finally the longest reigning president that we've ever had was Franklin D. Roosevelt. He died just shy of three months into his fourth term as president. So, he basically was president for just a little over twelve years. After his presidency, the passed a constitutional amendment in 1951 that prevented a president from serving no more than two terms.

As to go along with this green also has always been the color of eternity. We call certain plants and trees evergreen plants and trees because they stay the color of green all year round.

It is wonderful that the circle of the rainbow in Heaven reminds us of our God and His reign but it is also extremely merciful and gracious of our Heavenly Father to allow our sin ridden world that is perishing day by day to have so much reminder of our eternal God with the color of green being so prevalent in our world. This color allows us to know that though our world and our bodies are perishing through a personal relationship with Christ we too, can experience eternal life as well.

Listen to a few Bible verses about the eternity of our God. "Before the mountains were brought forth, or even you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God." (Ps. 90:2). "Have you not known? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary; His understanding is unsearchable." (Is. 40:28). "But of the Son He says, 'Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, the scepter of the uprightness is the scepter of your kingdom." (Heb. 1:8).

Therefore, since our God is the eternal God, we have nothing to fear because His kingdom will always be to which all His chosen people the redeemed of the earth belong to. Oh, blessed be our eternal God, Lord, and Savior.

2. Second, we identify the rainbow from the historical understanding of it. On earth, historically we first encounter a rainbow following the worldwide flood of Noah's day. (Gen. 9:13-17). We all know that God promised Noah, his family and all peoples who would once again dwell over the entire earth, that He would never again destroy the world by a world wide flood. So, every time a rainbow appears, we should be reminded that God brings judgment but following His judgment He will also restore and renew with mercy, grace, forgiveness, love and salvation.

This also reminds us that our Lord keeps His covenants with His people. In the remaining chapters of the Book of Revelation, we discover that God is going to pour out His wrath upon the earth like never before. However, the rainbow around the throne reminds us that God will also following that judgment fulfill the covenant that He made with Israel and that is to bring salvation to the entire nation of Israel. He made that covenant thousands of years ago and because again He's the eternal God. He can and will keep that promise no matter how hard Satan will try to prevent it from happening.

3. Third and finally we identify the rainbow from the color of it. Now we've mentioned one aspect of the color which is green and that is like the shape of this rainbow which is a circle. Both stand for eternity.

However, I want us to notice one more thing about the color green. It is a color that creates some great emotion with our lives. It is the color of joyfulness in our lives because once winter comes to our end the first color to come to life is green.

Also it is the color that is most soothing and relaxing to our eyes. We can much easier look upon green for a long period of time because of its soothing effect.

Therefore, this color reminds us that our eternal King upon the throne in Heaven will bring both eternal rest and eternal joy to our lives.

Concl. So, let us forever be grateful that John saw a rainbow of emerald, surrounding completely around the throne. It reminds us that our God is eternal, merciful and gracious. It reminds us that like the rainbow of old. He keeps His covenant with His people and that finally the color itself reminds us that God will bring eternal rest, comfort and joy to His people. Amen, Amen & Amen.




