From Pastor Ralph's Desk:

The Angels' Resurrection Direction

(Matthew 28:1-10)

Intro: Angels have always played a key role in God's work among mankind. When we read the Bible, we see their activity all over the place. We are even encouraged to treat strangers in a kind manner because we will never know when we might actually be entertaining angels. (Heb. 13:2)

However, the greatest work of the angels is the work they did for Jesus when He came among us. Particularly do we find them greatly involved at His birth and then at His resurrection and ascension, His coming into the world and His exit from the world. They will be also very active at His return as well.

Today I would like for us to focus upon the role of the angels at the resurrection of our Blessed Lord. Now the focus of what I want to see is the direction that the angels gave. So, the title of my message is The Angels' Resurrection Direction.

I. First, let us notice that the angels' resurrection direction came following the conquest. The angels did not come upon the scene until after Jesus had already conquered death and resurrected up out of the grave. The point being that the angels did not do one thing to help Jesus come up out of the grave. He didn't need their help to arise. He didn't need their help to come out of the grave. He didn't need the stone to be rolled back to come out of the tomb. No, my friend, Jesus had all the power needed to resurrect Himself up out of the grave. As a matter of fact, He alone had and has the power over, death, hell and the grave.

On one occasion as Jesus was teaching and preaching, He spoke of His authority and power over the grave. "The reason my Father loves me is that I lay down my life only to take it up again. No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have the authority to lay it down and the authority to take it up again. This command I received from My Father." (John 10:17-18).

So let us remember that the angels are powerful but not all powerful like Satan wants us to believe. No, no one is all powerful but our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We conquer sin, death, hell and the grave only through His power and authority.

II. Second, let us notice that the angels' resurrection direction started with a clearing. Now of course I am referring to the fact that we first discover the angels involvement in the resurrection event when they come down to roll the stone away from the tomb entrance. They cleared the way for all to see that Jesus had indeed and fact resurrected from the grave. They proved to the soldiers, the Roman government, the Jewish Sanhedrin and to Satan himself that they hade failed.

It also was to show to all of us that we, through faith in Christ, had won because He had won. By the way Jesus didn't need the stone removed to resurrect. The next time you encounter a stone to large for you to move, call on Jesus and let Him walk you right on through it, and we know that its true because the angels removed the stone to prove it.

III. Third, let us notice that the angels' resurrection direction stated a claim. Now, the claim was four words and those four words were, "He is not here..." the angels knew that the women and later the men who came to see the tomb were looking for the body of Jesus. However, the angels could clearly state to these followers of Christ that, "He is not here." in another one of the gospels, they said it this way, "Why seek ye the living among the dead?" (Luke 24:5). Now this is a very bold claim to make. As a matter of fact, from man's perspective, pretty much an impossible statement to make. But with these angels, we too, must make this bold statement that Jesus is no l9onger in the grave. The living is not a part of the dead. In our next point, we will see why the angels said He is not here.

IV. Fourth, let us notice that the angels' resurrection direction revealed the cause. Now, my point could really run right together because each one supports the other in a straight forward manner. For once the angel stated the claim that Jesus was not there in the tomb, He also followed right up with the reason or cause why He was not there, and of course, it was because He had risen from the grave.

It was extremely important to reveal the cause because at first the women thought that the tomb had been rolled away because either the Jews, or the soldiers had moved the body somewhere else. Or they may have concluded that someone simply came and stole the body which would in and of itself be almost impossible because of the soldiers.

However, the angels stated cause removed all conjecture as to why the tomb was open and the body was gone because the truth is no one took the body. He is gone because He arose. Amen and Praise the Lord.

V. Fifth, let us notice that the angels' resurrection direction gave absolute certainty. Now the angels appear to have had one primary responsibility and that responsibility was to convince the followers of Christ and as far as that goes anyone else who would listen that Jesus indeed and fact was risen from the dead.

Now the way in which they brought certainty to the Jesus resurrection was to first of all remind the women and the men that came to the tomb, that they could be sure that Jesus had resurrected from the dead because He had already told them that He would. On a number of occasions, He had told them that He must die but then three days later resurrect from the dead. Well, this reminder from the angel did its' job. Luke tells us that once the angel reminded them they did in fact remember that Jesus had said so. You can always trust Jesus to fulfill His promises and words because He always did and therefore always will.

The second means of certainty that the angels gave was a simple yet powerful invitation. "Come and see the place where He lay." this invitation was an invitation to actually witness for themselves that He wasn't there and that He had risen from the dead. There is absolutely no reason for us to deny or have difficulty with believing in the bodily resurrection of our Lord. For there was an untold number of witnesses who saw the empty tomb but not only the empty tomb but the actual presence of our exalted, risen Savior Jesus Christ our Lord.

Paul tells us that Jesus was seen by Peter and then by the twelve and even at one time by at least 500 of the Brethren and then by him last of all. The Gospels also reveal a few others. So let us rejoice 5that our faith is not a blind faith but a fait6h based in reality. So, we don't serve an ideal or a thought or a mere symbol or even a hope. No, sir, praise God our faith is in an absolute, actual, exalted risen Savior and Lord and His name is Jesus Christ. He lives.

VI. Sixth, let us notice that the angels' resurrection direction caused calm and celebration. The angels' words to the disciples of our Lord was, "Do not be afraid" or "Do not fear." now there is no way that at first did they couldn't have been afraid. However, as the angel worked gently with them assuring them of His resurrection, fear turned to calm and eventually calm into celebration.


Now, however, calm did not overtake the soldiers. Their fear was so deep that the Scriptures here tell us that the mighty Roman soldiers became like dead men. They were in total shock. Their fear was never swayed because they failed to accept the fact of what had happened. When you refuse to accept the reality of Christ' resurrection, you will live a life of fear because you have no certainty about your reality and future.

Let Jesus calm your fears and give you something to eternally rejoice about.

VII. Seventh, let us notice that the angels' resurrection direction concluded with a charge. After the angel convinced the women who first came to the tomb that Jesus had resurrected and after he clamed their fears, he then instructed them with the charge to go and report the good news of His resurrection to the rest of the disciples and this they did. This resulted in others coming to see and that resulted in them spreading the good news.

Concl. Well the Lord is telling us the same thing today. Go and tell that our Savior lives. Tell them that not sin, death, the grave, Satan or hell could hold Him back. He is alive. He is alive. Shout it out.






