From Fastor Ralph's Desk: Building The Church

(*Matt.* 16:13-20)

Intro: As we start a series of messages focusing on the church. I wanted to begin in the Bible with the first mention of the church in the New Testament. It is here in these verses that the Lord reveals to His disciples and to us as well, that He is going to build the church. So, if we want to understand what it means to be the church, then it behooves us to take a careful look at this set of verses. I am simply naming my message, "Building The Church."

I. First, as we examine building the church, let us notice the founder and formation of the church. In other words, how is it that the church has come to be? Well, we don't have to do a whole lot of searching to find that answer. The Lord spills right out there for us to plainly see that the church was founded by His dear own hands, head and heart. These are the very words that let us know that, "...and on this rock I will build my church." So, the formation of the church came from one source and on one source only, our Lord Jesus Christ Himself.

Now this goes directly against the teaching of various religious denominations.

However, let us be assured that the church was not founded or formed by the disciples, apostles, pastors or popes, just Jesus. So, the result of this is that as we labor in the building of the church, we have the responsibility to do it the way the builder intends on it being done. Oh, thank God that the founder and thus the formation of the church is in the hands of the blessed Son of God. Therefore, it not only will get built, but it will be completed. Amen. **II. Second, as we examine building the church, let us notice the foundation of the church.** When building any type of building, you don't begin with the roof and you don't begin with the walls and you don't begin with the floors. Obviously you must start with the foundation which will support the floors, walls, and roof.

Now, you can build a building with a shoddy foundation but it will not stand the test of time. My dad and I spent many hours underneath homes with weak foundations shoring them up with more solid foundations that will allow the building many more years of life.

Well, when our Lord decided to build the church, He determined to build it on a foundation that would stand the test of time and when I say time, I am referring to His kind of time, Eternity. The only thing that He knew that could do that was none other than Himself. Let me point out how the Lord revealed this. After Jesus had informed Peter that His statement that He was the Christ the Son of the Living God was revealed to Him from the Heavenly Father, He then revealed to Peter that his name means, in Greek, a piece of rock or a little rock. Then, however, He revealed though that the church would not be built on him as a piece of rock. That is the recorded meaning of the other word rock he used, and that massive rock is Himself. Paul verifies that truth for us when he said, "By the grace God has given me, I laid a foundation as an expert builder, and someone is building on it. But each one should be careful how he builds. For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ." (I Cor. 3:10-11).

Oh, dear Child of God, let us rejoice that we belong to the church of the eternal living Savior and on Him it is built, thus we will forever have a solid, secure foundation under us. Amen.

III. Third, as we examine building the church, let us notice the fu-<u>ture of the church.</u> Well, we've already noted that the church's future is solid and secure because it has the most secure foundation it could ever have, the Lord Jesus Christ Himself. He is a massive, unbreakable, eternal rock. We can't be shaken to ruins.

However, the future of the church is not only solid and eternally secure because it has a perfect foundation under it, but it is eternally secure also because of the promise or guarantee made by the builder of the church. The promise that Jesus made gives us the absolute assurance that the church will survive and thrive throughout all eternity. That guarantee and promise He made was, "...and the gates of Hades will not overcome it." (vs. 18). Next to the greatest force outside of the Lord is the forces of Hell, Satan and all his demonic forces. Satan is the leader of all that is evil, wicked and the realm of death. Well we must remember that Satan and all the forces of Hell with him are created beings. Our Lord Jesus Christ is not a created being. He is the eternal Son of God. He actually created Satan and his demons to be good angels and glory but they rebelled. But their rebellion was unsuccessful and they were kicked out of glory. The created cannot conquer the eternal.

Second, however, Jesus not only conquered the forces of Hell because of His eternal power over the created, He also conquered everything that Satan controls when He came to earth and took on flesh. He defeated sin at the cross by bearing its' judgment and three days later He conquered death, hell and the grave when He arose. So, when Jesus made the promise that the gates of Hades shall not overcome it you can one hundred percent count on it.

So, dear friends, don't ever give up on the church. With all of her faults and hardships, she will absolutely come out on top because nothing will ever be able to ultimately knock her out. If you want to invest in that it will give back eternal dividends, then the church is the only place.

IV. Fourth, as we examine building the church, let us notice the Fabricator of the church. To fabricate means to assemble. Though Jesus Christ is the Founder, Builder and Foundation of the church, He is using His people to assemble the church together. We are His laborers in the work force. He told Peter that He was giving to him the keys of the Kingdom. This means that He was giving to Peter, who represents the church, the authority to carry out, in conjunction with Him of course, the labor and work necessary to build the church.

When we are doing the work of building up the church, we are showing to the world that through us Christ is building His church. So, the question is are you working in conjunction with our Lord to help assemble together His church? There is no such thing as a workless Christian.

V. Fifth, as we examine building the church, let us notice the fo-

<u>cus of the church.</u> When Jesus told Peter that he was representing the church, thus all Believer, was to us the keys of the Kingdom for the purpose of binding and loosing. What most scholars believe, believe Jesus meant was that by the church preaching the Gospel message of our Lord Jesus Christ, some would be bound for Heaven as they received Christ as their Savior. Others would be loosed or lost from Heaven because they refused to believe in the Gospel message of salvation. So the tasks of the church has been given is to boldly and unashamedly declare that Christ and Christ alone is the only means of salvation. There is to be then just on focus, Jesus Christ.

VI. Finally, as we examine building the church, let us notice the force of the church. In other words, where do we get the power to do this work that has been given to us? Well, the answer is like the others, very simple. Jesus told Peter that the Heavenly Father had revealed to him the truth of whom Jesus is. He also told Peter that it was He who would build the church, and finally Jesus told him that He was giving him the keys to the Kingdom. So, the simple answer is that our Lord is reminding Peter and us that He's the force to carry out the work. Through the person of the Holy Spirit, God empowers us to do the work of building the church. May we ever cry out for and depend on Him to get the work done.

Concl. Now it is simple when you see this passage of Scripture which is the first one on the church, you are encouraged to move boldly forward in working with our Lord in building the church because it is absolutely surround in, around, above and below our Lord Jesus Christ.


