

From Pastor Ralph's Desk:

Fixing The Way We Are

(Rom. 1:14-32)

Intro: Our trip to the Creation Museum and the replica of Noah's Ark stirred up in my heart and mind once again why we as a nation and as a world are so messed up. It reminded me why anymore right is wrong and wrong is right. It also reminded me why we are at the place where actual facts and truths are condemned and theories and speculations are praised without factual evidence to back them up.

There are more examples of this than we really have time to mention. Let me mention just a few of how far we have strayed. In just a few days back a lady in Virginia was dying and one of her last requests was that her young healthy dog be put to sleep and buried with her. Well this caused many people in the state to boil angry red. They couldn't imagine that anyone could be so selfish as to put a young healthy dog to sleep so that he could be buried with its' owner. Politicians were riled up to the point over this one dog that they were talking about creating a law in the state to prevent this from ever happening. Now there is nothing wrong with being upset over the matter. However, let us not forget what the governor of this same state said just recently. He basically said that if a woman gives birth to a child and decides for whatever reason, she doesn't want the child, she can just leave him or her there where the child was born and let them die. How have we come to a place where we can get riled up over a puppy but not a child created in the image of God. God help us.

One more incident I will mention that shows how messed up we've become. In the state of Connecticut, a young lady was competing in a track event that she worked hard at to be able to represent her state in a national completion which she hoped would possibly be able to eventually qualify her for competing in the Olympics. However, a anew law by the state of Connecticut destroyed her ability to advance on for her state. They had just passed a law that allowed transgender persons to compete in which ever group they chose to compete in. Well two transgender guys chose to compete in the girls track event. This caused her to finish eighth instead of sixth. As the result, she could not compete any further because there being there knocked her out and some others. Now, two male persons are going to be representing the girls team on the national level. Boy are we screwed up. Right is wrong and wrong is right.

Well I want to begin today with these set of verses to examine how we've got in the mess we are in and what we can do to fix this enormous mess we've gotten into. Today we will only get through the first point of this message. Fixing the way we are.

I. First, fixing the way we are must begin with understanding what's the problem. Well there is good news and there is bad news. The good news is that we indeed know what the problem is. The bad news is that we indeed know what the problem is. Thankfully according to the good news side of it, we can know what the problem is and we can know what needs to be done because we know what the problem is.

Now, I'm sure that if we were to ask everyone listening or reading this message what is the problem with our country, and our world, that we're in the mess we're all in, I'm confident that we would come up with as many answers as there are persons who are listening and reading.

However, many if not most answers that would be given would probably most likely be the symptoms or consequences of the problem. For example, someone might say that the problem with why we are in the mess that we are in is because our homes in America are falling apart, marriages are no longer taken seriously and our children are treated like they are more of a nuisance than gifts from God to raise for His glory. Now it sounds like indeed that there are major problems and they are. However, these problems have come about as the resul of the one over arching problem. They are the consequences of the one major issue. So by now, we are asking ourselves, well what in the world is that problem that has resulted in all the other problems?

The Apostle Paul under the leadership of the Lord gets right down to the over arching problem of humanity that has led to all other problems. It was a problem that began in the garden and has persisted ever since. At times, however, the problem is more pronounced than at other times, and I believe that our country has been for the last several years, have made the problem more pronounced than it has ever been in our history.

Now let us reveal exactly what the Apostle Paul is these verses said it was. In verse eighteen Paul tells us that through their wickedness they, "suppress the truth." Well, immediately we want to know what truth is it that we are suppressing? Well, Paul gives us that answer in the next set of verses. The truth that they wee purposely suppressing and tragically we still are is the truth of the knowledge of God. "Furthermore, since they did not think it worthwhile to retain the knowledge of God, He gave them over to a depraved mind to do what ought not to be done." (vs. 28).

Our country has been following this same direction ever since they decided to take God our of our schools. Starting back as far as 1925 when the famous scopes monkey trial took place in the state of Tennessee which pretty much introduced evolution as the primary means of teaching biology in our schools and pushed creationism our of our schools as a means of our existence.

Then God was pushed further out of our schools when a lacy bu the name of Madelyn Murray O'Hare. In 1963, she contested the fact that her son William Murray had to sit through Bible reading and prayer in his public school. She took the case all the way to the Supreme Court and managed to get prayer and Bible reading removed from our public schools. The Supreme Court and Atheists around our country under O'Hare's guidance, promoted a statement that has been attributed to our Constitution but is really not there. That statement clause is called the separation of church and state. That statement is not in our Constitution. However, to this day it is the anthem of all who are trying to push God completely out of our public arena. Every Year we hear the cries of our growing hostile crowds that demand any symbols of our faith has to go from the public squares because there must be the separation of church and state.

However, the tragedy is that our Constitution while it prevents the state from having its' own particular religion. It also provides for our freedom and right to promote and practice our faith without interference. They seem to have forgotten that that's also in the Constitution. Now, once we refuse to accept the knowledge of God, then anything can go. Because if you suppress the knowledge of God and choose not to retain His knowledge then you therefore also refuse to acknowledge His direction for our lives and how they should be lived out. That means that you don't have a God you have to answer to but yourself or whoever makes themselves ruler over your lives. So, we can see why all the problems we have are so many and so messy because God is suppressed, then we feel free to live our lives just anyway we want to without any accountability.

Now, however, there is just one problem to their suppression of the truth and that problem is that no matter how hard they try, and as we've shown they have tried with all their might, they have not been able to fully suppress the truth of God because as Paul says here, his evidence in creation alone is just too overwhelming to be able to cover up the existence of our Almighty God. In other words, Paul is saying here in these verses that if you don't retain the knowledge of God it is not because the evidence is not there. Rather, it is because you purposely choose to ignore both your conscious and the evidence which is overwhelming. As a matter of fact, Paul tells us that since the beginning of creation, "God's invisible qualities—His eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made."

Now this is what made our trip to the Creation Museum and the Ark Encounter so special. At both of these places you are shown more evidence of God in creation than you could ever imagine or number. What each of the displays primarily remind us of is that in everything that exists, even in the simplest of things, there is too much order and complicated that it is impossible for these things to have just come about by mere chance or accidently.

Things are so precise in the order of things that if they were just an inkling one way or the other, they would fall apart and cease to be. Also, in each of our genetic codes there is information that has been placed there. That information tells our cells exactly what they can do or can't do. Where did the information that was and is come from? It came from our God our Creator. For the information contained in our genetic code could not have accidently or by mere chance gotten there. Someone had to have placed it there and that someone is our God.

Concl. Now, as we come to our conclusion, I think that it is extremely important that we understand what Paul says about those who choose to suppress the truth of the knowledge of our God. As a matter of fact he makes the statement to cover all human beings. The statement is, "...so that men are without excuse." (vs. 20). Another translation put it this way, "...so they have not excuse whatsoever for not knowing God." (vs. 20 NLT).

So, those of you who are either running from God, or using the excuse that God doesn't exist, stop your running and your excuses and see the evidence of God that is so clearly given and run to Him, and trust Him as both your Creator and Savior.

Also, Children of God, stand up unashamedly for the knowledge of God and boldly proclaim and reveal His truths from Creation and from His Holy Word.
