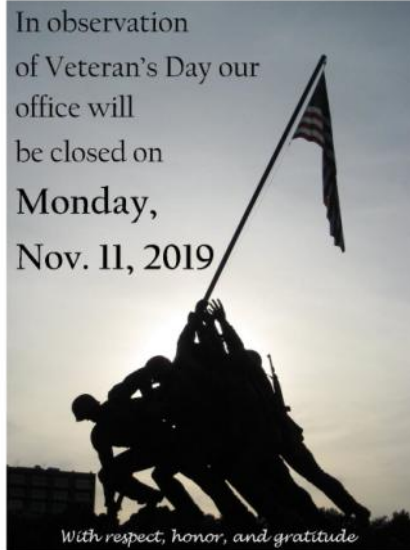

Where?

Registration takes place in front of Beaufort City Hall on Boundary Street. After opening remarks and prayer by a local pastor, participants proceed to the sidewalk and spread out in both directions from City Hall. We stand together holding signs that read:
* Pray To END ABORTION*
We remain in silent prayer for one hour, rain OR shine.

Why?

Our Christian values are under attack in this country. We need to come together as brothers and sisters in Christ to pray. We are called to take a stand for the truth. Abortion is an atrocity that must end! In the United States the facts are:
- Since 1973, 60+ million babies have been killed by abortion.
- Over 3,500 innocent lives are destroyed every DAY
- 90% of Down Syndrome babies are killed by abortionists
- One out of every 4 pregnancies ends in abortion

Christmas Prisoner Packets

The ministry is a joint effort of SCDH and SCDMNM. As the project has grown, we have been able to give family and generous!

Since 1976
Last year, you helped create approximately 24,000 packets. All extra packets were given to inmates who arrived from the distribution sites.

Many inmates have no visitors. Your gift of Christmas provides hope and love to these inmates.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why do the envelopes need to be flame embossed?
The South Carolina Department of Corrections policy states they can be sealed to ensure they are not tampered with.

Can I include a gospel tract, Christmas card, or note in the packet?
No, you may NOT add tracts, cards, or notes to the packets. Please do not place any extra items in the packets. The "Scripture booklet" will be placed in each packet by volunteers of St. Andrew's Baptist Church on December 9.

Why do we need to check the contents of our packets before delivering them to St. Andrew's Baptist Church?
The packets must be checked to be sure their oil contents meet the requirement of the SC Department of Corrections. Checking your packets saves valuable time and resources from being spent to replace incorrect or missing items on December 9.

Why are we no particular about what goes into the packets?
The Department of Corrections decides what goes in each packet. All packets must contain the same items, quantity, and sizes to prevent conflicts among inmates. Extra items are removed to keep packets uniform.

Approved Packing List from SC Department of Corrections

- ONE black non-reflectable pen (no wire clip, no other color ink)
 - ONE writing tablet no larger than 5 1/2" x 8" (no wire bound books, composition books, or post-it notes)
 - ONE adult toothbrush (individually factory-sealed, no multi-packs)
 - ONE 4 oz or 6 oz toothpaste (no travel size)
 - ONE 3 oz or 6 oz bar of soap (no travel size, no unwrapped/unboxed bars)
 - TWO rolls of hard candy like LifeSavers, Mentos, Breath Savers (NO Smarties, Sweetarts, Necco Wafers, Rolos, Starburst, TicTacs)
 - FIVE first-class **A10 Stamp-Embossed Envelopes** (from US Post Office- NO gallon stamps, no other size envelope)
 - ONE rubber size zipper bag (no other size bags accepted)
- ALL ITEMS MUST FIT IN THE ZIPPER BAG WITH ZIPPER CLOSED SECURELY.**
- DO NOT INCLUDE: washcloths, toothbrush holders, floss, combs
- Extra approved items may be sent to St. Andrew's Baptist Church on collection day in a bag/box marked "extra items."
