

From Fastor Ralph's Desk:

## **Getting Your Joy Back**

(II Kings 6:1-7)

Intro: While at the Senior Adult Celebrator's Conference, we heard a message from Dr. Phil Waldrep on recapturing your joy. He shared with us that he lost his joy early on in his ministry but God gave him the means to recover that joy. He also explained how his dad had lost his and recovered it as well.

Now to explain how they recovered their joy, he used as event that took place in the life of the Prophet Elisha. During this event, a gentleman clearly lost his joy but he also got it back. Dr. Phil Waldrep saw in this man loss of joy and recovery to be much like what had happened to him and his dad. So, today, I too, want us to examine how to get your how back.

**I. First, getting your joy back implies that you can lose your joy.** Now, obviously this point is not a new discovery to us. But from time to time, we need to be reminded of what is obvious. For when something is obvious we often don't think about it . However, in order, for us to recapture our joy, we need to simply come to the point to understand that we have lost it. In the event that we are looking at one of the sons of the prophets lost his joy and to everyone that there it was obvious when and why he lost his joy. The man was chopping a tree down when the head of his axe flew off and fell into the Jordan river. When this happened he couldn't function anymore and panic had set in. he then cried out for help.

So, in this man's case, it was an accident that caused him to lose his joy. Of course, there may have been other contributing factors in the loss of his joy. We know that the axe didn't belong to him. Also, however he too may have over exerted himself and may be he wasn't paying close attention to what was about to happen and know that he could have prevented it. Which ever it was, clearly the circumstances of his situation, he allowed to rob him of his joy.

So, let us ask ourselves the question, what is it that has caused us to allow our joy to be lost? What circumstances, accident or tragedy or bad choices and misbehavior, has robbed us of our joy? We must first realize that we have for some reason or reasons lost our joy if we are to get it back.

**II. Second, getting our joy back requires acknowledging and** <u>confessing the loss of your joy.</u> In our present set of verses, it is completely obvious as to when one of the sons of prophets lost his joy. For this particular gentleman cried to the top of his voice when he lost his axe head, "Oh my Lord, he cried out, it was borrowed." the manner, the attitude, and the words he used clearly reveals that he no longer was joyful. He was not able to function, or carry on, or contribute at least he felt that way. Now the only way he was going to get his joy back was to get the axe head back. You've got to understand that was a big loss because without modern technology and equipment, an axe head was extremely important. Second, obviously it was a big loss because it was borrowed. So again, it was clearly understandable of why he lost his joy.

Also, however, it is understandable why he cried out acknowledging and confessing it had happened. For otherwise, he would not have received the help needed and the process started of retrieving the very thing that could restore his joy. By acknowledging and confessing he was on his way to a recovery. We, too, must come to a place in our lives when the joy is gone to acknowledge and confess that it is gone so that the process of recovery can begin in our lives. Even if we are not sure why the joy is gone, by simply acknowledging that it has will help you begin the journey of finding out why and what to do. For if you fail to do so, you will continue to remain in a spirit of sorrowfulness which can in turn, turn to bitterness and ineffectiveness. King David is a prime example of someone who lost his joy and who for sometime became ineffective, sorrowful, and even bitter because he kept it all bottled up inside.

However, once he let loose and acknowledged that he had lost his joy and confessed the process of healing, restoration and recovery of joy began. As a matter of fact, he took an entire chapter to make this confession which is all of Psalm fifty-one. But because it was a long confession, the recovery of joy immediately began to be possible. Have you cried out your acknowledgment and confession of the loss f your joy?

**III. Third, getting your joy back requires a willingness to let** <u>other Believers help us get our joy back.</u> When this gentleman cried out he was specifically crying out to the prophet Elisha. So, he turned to both a fellow Believer and prophet. His cry did not go unanswered. The prophet Elisha responded immediately to a plea for help.

Now, it wasn't Elisha who ultimately made it possible for the gentleman to get his joy back. However, God used Elisha as part of the means of the joy coming back. In other words, we are part of the manner and means that God uses to help people get their joy back. The Apostle tells us to "carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the Law of Christ." (Gal. 6:2).

So, when we lose our joy let us turn to a fellow Believer that we can trust and seek their help and guidance to be a part of our solution for getting our joy back.

**IV. Fourth, getting our joy back requires knowing that only** <u>the power of God will truly give us back our joy.</u> When the gentleman who had lost his axe head cried out showing that clearly he had lost his joy, Elisha responded by asking where the axe head had fallen into the river. When the gentleman showed him, Elisha threw in a stick at that particular location and miraculously the iron axe head floated to the top of the water. Now, I used the word miraculously because that is exactly what it was. Elisha did not have the power in himself nor the ability to make an iron axe head float. This can only be understood that God in His awesome power heard the cry of the gentleman who had lost it, and the prayer of the prophet Elisha and by His wonder working power raised the iron axe head out of the water.

When we lose our axe heads that cause us to lose our joy, no matter what the reason, the only true power that can bring it back is the power of Almighty God.

Let us not linger long in the cesspool of sadness, sorrow, bitterness and ineffectiveness when there is the awesome power of our loving God to give us back our joy.

Concl. As we conclude, there is one last thing that is important that we must do to get our joy back. When Elisha, under God's leadership, raised up the axe head, he then instructed the man to walk out to the river's edge and pick the axe head up out of the water. In other words, his joy was not completely restored until he reached down and took hold of the very thing that caused him to lose it in the first place. So, the point in this is whatever God raises up to give us our joy back, we must reach out and take a hold of it before our joy can be completely restored. So what has God raised and said that if you take a hold of your joy will come back? Is it to take a hold of getting back into reading the Bible or praying? Is it repenting of a specific sin? Is it forgiving someone? Or is it serving in a certain position? Well, whatever it is reach out and take hold.

\* PRAY TO END ABORTION\* We remain in silent prayer for one hour, rain OR shine.


