You Have Abundant Life

Intro: This message is for the purpose of reminding God's people that in these troubling and confusing times we have abundant life. No matter what the times are like or hold for us abundant life remains true and faithful for the people of God. So, let us take a look at the abundant life the people of God have and let it encourage us through these days. My title is simply "You Have Abundant Life."

I. First, let us notice why you have abundant life. (vs. 10).

Well, it is quite clear in this verse that we don't have abundant life because we were able to work it p on our own. It is also clear that we don't have it because many other persons made it possible for us. So, if it doesn't come from us or from many other persons then where did or where does it come from?

So, the verse is straight forward about where our abundant life comes from. First, it tells us where it doesn't come from as mentioned above. Jesus said that there was and there still are thieves who sneak in amongst us who try to convince us that they can offer it to us but Jesus said all they really want to do is to steal, kill, and destroy.

Next, however, praise God He makes it as plain as it can be stated as to where abundant life comes from. He said, "I have come that they may have life and have it to the full." (vs. 10). So, if anyone wants to experience abundant life to the full then there is only one place it can be found in the person of Jesus Christ our Lord. Now, let me point out that Jesus doesn't just give us a little better life or pretty good life. No, the great Greek scholar Kenneth Wuest said, the abundant life that Jesus came to give us is life in "superabundance." So, if we want life in superabundance, then we need to come to Christ.

Now, the reason why Christ Jesus our Lord is able to give us this super abundant life is because He did what was necessary to make it possible. You see, because we were born in sin, the Bible is clear that this has made us spiritually dead. (Eph. 2:1-3). What was needed for us was someone who could interject new life back into us. Well, this is exactly what Jesus has done for us. By going to the cross, Jesus paid the price for our sins so we could experience forgiveness. Then, He was buried and on the third day, up out of the grave He came, totally conquering the very things that held us in bondage and death. With His resurrection power, He can infuse us with His presence restoring spiritual life, abundant, eternal life. Oh, what a Savior.

II. Second, let us notice, what does it mean that you have abundant life?

What it means to have abundant life is found within the context of the Shepherd and His sheep. It also is found in a contrast between the true Shepherd and the fake ones.

So, what we discover from these verses is that what abundant life is, is the intimate relationship between the Shepherd and His sheep. We know that throughout history, the relationship between a shepherd and his sheep have always been special, close, caring and so much more. It is a bond rarely found anywhere else. Out of this special relationship, the sheep have wound up being blessed beyond measure because their shepherd does all that is necessary and more to make their life where all their needs are met.

Now, for the Christian, what this means is that our lives are lives that are full and super abundant because of who our Shepherd is. He is the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the living God. There has never been a shepherd like Him. All other shepherds that have been or will be can't measure p to the One who rose up out of the grave.

Our Shepherd, He talks to us; walks with us; protects us; feeds us; provides for us; and leads us. These things He will do for us throughout eternity. So, what it means to have that super abundant life is to have the privilege of having Jesus as our eternal, permanent, good and great Shepherd who will forever walk with us in an intimate, personal relationship, make our life abundant and full. Now, in contrast, all others who pretend to really are only about themselves. They really don't care about what happens to us. As a matter of fact, all they offer is to steal us, kill us and destroy us. They have come to take our life, Jesus came to give life abundant and eternal.

Now, it is important that I make sure that we don't understand that abundant life necessarily means a long life or a comfortable life in this world. For Christ our Lord Himself didn't experience either a long life or a comfortable life. However, His life was abundant because His Heavenly Father walked with Him and saw Him through the battles of life as Jesus does with us. We will face nothing apart from Jesus our good Shepherd. Then ultimately He will deliver us from this old sinful world where our life will eternally be comfortable. Amen.

III. Third, let us notice who it is that we say you have abundant life. (vs. 7-9).

I want belabor this point for Jesus lays it our when He said, "I am the gate, whoever enters through me will be saved. He will come in and go out, and find pasture." So, who do we say you have abundant life? Well, it is anyone or whosoever enters the sheepfold through Christ and Christ alone.

So, if you want to enter God's sheepfold and have both abundant life and eternal life, then you must come to Christ, repent of your sins and trust Him as Lord and Savior and you will have life full, free and super abundant. So, I pray that you will be one of the whoever enters through Christ Jesus the gate that leads to abundant life in the sheepfold of God.

Concl. So, the more we focus upon our Shepherd, the more we will know the super abundant life He came to give us. However, the more we listen to others voice the more we will not experience abundant life. So, I pray that you will listen to and look to only the true Shepherd Jesus Christ our Lord, and the way we do that is to dive into His Holy Word. The Bible, God's Holy Word.


