God's Love For His People

(Hosea 1:1-3, 3:1-5))

Intro: History has given us some great love stories such as Abraham and Sarah; Isaac and Rebekah; Jacob and Rachel; Ruth and Boaz. Romeo and Juliet and many more.

However, none of these love stories can even begin to touch the love story of God's love for His people. The Book of Hosea is one of the places in God's Holy Word where we clearly see the amazing and incomparable love that God has for His people.

There are many people who would say that the Book of Hosea shouldn't be in the Bible because god told Hosea to go and marry a lady that will be unfaithful to him. These people would say that we don't want to be encouraging people to go around looking for a mate that they know will be unfaithful to them.

However, what we need to understand is that God is not using the Book of Hosea as a book to tell us how to pick our mates. Rather God told Hosea to go and marry an adulterous woman to us as an example of His love for the nation of Israel even though they had been unfaithful to Him just as Hosea's wife was to him. In spite of her unfaithfulness to him, Hosea loved her again and again. The same is true of God's love to His people. So, let us look at this love story that has no comparison.

I. First, let us notice that God's love for His people is undeserving. (1:1-3). Now, Hosea did exactly what God told him to do. He went and found a lady by the name of Gomer who had a reputation for loose and immoral standards when it comes to relationships with men, and after marrying her she lived up to her reputation and had an adulterous relationship with someone else while they were married.

So the point here is that Hosea didn't marry her because she was deserving of his commitment to her. Nom he married her even though he knew she wasn't going to be faithful to him. So, his marriage to her was completely and totally a choice he had to make in spite of her unfaithfulness and her undeservingness.

So, it is that God has chosen our of His essence of love to love us even though we aren't deserving of His love. The Apostle Paul said this way, "As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient. All of us also lived among them at one time, gratifying the cravings of our sinful nature and following it's desires and thoughts. Like the rest, we were by nature objects of wrath. But because of His great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—It is by grace you have been saved." (Eph. 2:1-5).

Grace means something that you receive undeservingly. So, it is that out of His great love for us and His grace He has saved His people even though we don't deserve it, Amen and praise be unto our God.

II. Second, let us notice that God's love for His people is unconditional. (3:1-3). Now, as we've already noted that God told Hosea not only to marry an adulteress woman but He also told him to go and love Gomer again after she had run around on him. Hosea did exactly as God had told him to and went and got her back and loved her again.

Now, god told Hosea to do this as an example of His one love for His people even though they had been adulterers in their relationships with Him by going after other false gods and idols. He place no conditions on His love for them. In other words, He was not going to allow their actions to keep Him from loving them.

However, this does not mean that we can live any way we want to regardless of what God says and He won't care at all. No, nothing can be further from the truth. If that is your attitude, then I doubt very seriously if you've ever been saved to begin with.

What we have to remember is that it is God's love that brought the nation under great judgment for their sins and led them into captivity where they repented of their idolatry and returned to believing in god and god alone. So, His love led to discipline and His discipline led to faith.

Thank God, however, for His unconditional love for us even when we go through periods of unfaithfulness to Him. The Psalmist reveals this great truth to us.

"The LORD is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love. He will not always accuse, nor will he harbor his anger forever; he does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us. As a father has compassion on his children, so the LORD has compassion on those who fear him; for he knows how we are formed, he remembers that we are dust. As for man, his days are like grass, he flourishes like a flower of the field; the wind blows over it and it is gone, and its place remembers it no more. But from everlasting to everlasting the LORD's love is with those who fear him, and his righteousness with their children's children—with those who keep his covenant and remember to obey his precepts."

III. Third, let us notice that God's love for His people is unending. (3:1-

<u>5).</u> So once again, let us be reminded that God told Hosea to go get his wife back again out of her adulterous affair and love her again and again. So Hosea's love for Gomer was to never run out. So, God was using this as an example that His love for His people will never run out. His love is an eternal love for His people. It began in eternity past and will continue for eternity future.

"The Lord appeared to us in the past, saying: I have love you with an everlasting love: I have drawn you with loving kindness." (Jer. 31:3).

"But from everlasting to everlasting the Lord's love is with those who fear Him and His righteousness with their children's children" (Ps. 103:17). So, never think that God stops loving you. It is eternal.

IV. Fourth, let us notice that God's love for His people in unequaled . (3:2

-3). Now, the reason why God's love is unequaled because God told Hosea to go and get his wife back, but before he could he had to pay an enormous price to make it happen. We're not exactly sure what the money was for but it was enough to buy a slave at that time. Therefore, to get the woman that was already his wife back again he paid an exorbitant amount to show his love to her again.

Well, we know that like Hosea, God paid an exorbitant amount, more than any other, that He might purchase us and make us His very own so He could lavish His love on us. "Dear Friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made completer in us." I John 4:7-12.

Concl. It is so great to be a part of this great love story. You can too if you will only repent and trust Christ as your Lord and Savior.


