

From Pastor Ralph's Desk:



Finding Freedom

(John 8:31-59)

Intro: For the time being, our nation is still the freest nation on earth. Our Founding Fathers made sure that the individual has the rights afforded to each one that God our Creator meant for us to have.

We have the right to freely worship our God to express our views and beliefs. We have the right to own property and a gun to defend it. We have the right to live where we choose, seek the employment we desire and the list goes on and on.

Now it is because of these freedoms that very few want to leave our country while hundreds of thousands are seeking to get into our country to enjoy the freedoms and protections that we offer though sadly being challenged by the progressives.

However, though we have all of these great freedoms, yet we hear the words of Jesus saying to us that the freedoms afforded to us in our great country are not that kind of freedom that truly sets us free. No, there is freedom that only Jesus can offer us that will eternally make us free.

Therefore it greatly behooves us to discover this freedom that is not offered to us from Washington, D.C., but, rather from heaven's throne. So, let us find freedom.

<u>I. First, we need to recognize that finding freedom involves meeting certain requirements.</u>

The people that Jesus was speaking to in these verses believed that they already were a free set of people.

However, Jesus quickly dispelled their myths by revealing that there were certain things that had failed to meet in order to truly be free. So, let us look at those requirements that they were not meeting up to.

A. First, there is a reality requirement. Now, what exactly is that reality requirement that they had not come to grips with? Well, it was the reality that they weren't free after all, and they weren't free after all because Jesus said, "I tell you the truth, everyone who sins is a slave to sin." (vs. 34). Well, that verse reveals the reality that we all are not free because we all have sinned. Therefore until that issue is dealt with in our lives no matter what country you live in, no matter how free you are, you aren't free because you are enslaved to sin.

Our national leaders, in many settings, believe that we are making our country free by pushing our country to grow up and accept all of these sexual preferences as normal and would benefit our nation and make us more free.

However, the reality is that what they are doing is promoting all of these sexual preferences is further enslaving us because all of these sexual preferences outside of marriage between a man and a woman is point blank sin.

So, if we are going to find freedom as Jesus intended that we must first come to the reality that we are enslaved to sin and therefore need to find freedom.

B. Second, there is a designation requirement. Now, what I mean by this is that we must resign from the fact that there is absolutely nothing that we personally can do that will set us free from our enslavement to sin.

Jesus' audience declared that they weren't enslaved because they were Abraham's descendants. However, Jesus acknowledged that although hey physically were Abraham's descendants they were far from being anything like Abraham by their actions and words because they were seeking to kill Jesus for His words which the Father had given to Him. Actually, Jesus goes on to say that their real father was the devil.

So, my point is that we can't look to our ancestry or our own works or efforts to be able to free us from this enslavement. No, it is going to take someone greater and beyond our abilities to be able to set us free. Thank God as my next point shows there is someone.

II. Second, we need to understand that finding freedom has a remedy.

Now, up front is this whole conversation Jesus plainly reveals the remedy for our enslavement to sin when He said these words, "then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." (vs. 32).

Now, we have to ask ourselves if it is the truth that sets us free then what truth is it that Jesus is referring to? To answer this question, you have to look at the whole context of these verses. In the previous verses to our set of verses, Jesus has been revealing to the people who He was and what the Heavenly Father had sent Him to do. This is the truth He's talking about. In other words, He is the truth.

Therefore, Jesus is saying yes you are enslaved to sin and there is nothing you yourself can do to undo that enslavement but there is a truth that can and that truth is Me. I can set you free. He plainly said it when He said, "So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed." (vs. 36).

So, the remedy is to totally surrender yourself to the Lord Jesus Christ as the only truth, way and life that can free you from sin.

As our soldiers fought and sacrificed their lives to give us the kind of freedom we have in this country, Jesus made the ultimate sacrifice on Calvary's cross taking all the wrath of God poured out upon our sins placed upon Him so that by His death we could have life free of enslavement to sin. Have you surrendered your life to Him? He alone can free you.

III. Third, we need to understand that finding freedom has results.

- A. The first result is relational. This means that with the freedom Jesus is offering will bring you into a personal relationship with Him and you will be a Child of God. He told them that a slave has no permanent place in the family. However, through Christ, they become sons and daughters in God's family. So, do you have that personal relationship with Jesus" It is all that matters.
- B. <u>The second result is eternal.</u> As I just said in my previous point, "a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever." (vs. 35). If you want to spend eternity in heaven with Jesus, then you need to be a child of God and that will be forever.
- C. <u>The third result is devotional.</u> In the beginning of our verses Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples." (vs. 31.).

You see, Jesus was saying to those who supposedly had come to believe in Him, they would prove that by their faithfulness to His teachings, the point when you truly come to Christ, it will result in you loving and seeking to follow the teachings of Christ. You will devote yourself to His Word.

Tragically, many in this setting who claimed to have believed in Him, just a short time later were calling for Him to be crucified. Their faith was never real. So ask yourself, has your belief resulted in your devotion to Christ and His teaching? If not then maybe you need to ask God to help you to believe in a way that will lead to a life of commitment and devotion to Christ and His teachings.

D. <u>The fourth result is joyful.</u> This is the simple one to show and you are free. It will bring joy unspeakable and full of glory. For you will know that with God you are forgiven because of Christ and therefore are accepted. You can't get any more joyful than that.

Concl: in conclusion, find Jesus and you find freedom!




