



From Pastor Ralph's Desk:

God Is Great (Daniel 2:45-49)

Intro: In our last message, we examined the content and interpretation of King Nebuchadnezzar's dream. In this message I want us to examine the reactions of both the prophet Daniel and the king to the revelation of the dream.

I believe that the best reaction was found in the statement that Daniel made about God when he told the king that God was as he put it, "...the Great God." (vs. 45). As we continue reading the text we clearly can see that King Nebuchadnezzar's concern with the prophet Daniel was that God is indeed great.

We often say now days over and over that Our God is Good. We express those words to one another often. We even have written songs concerning this phrase. But what I want to make sure is that we understand that God is good because God is great. So, today, we are going to look at why the prophet and the king agreed that our God is Great. As Tony the Tiger use to say that Kellogg's taste Greattttttt! Well indeed our God is the Greatest.

I. First, God is great because He has shown mysteries to mankind. (vs. 45). Now, not just any mystery but rather mysteries that have been in the heart and mind of God in eternity past. Therefore, we are blessed from God to have received eternal mysteries.

Praise be unto our Eternal, Holy and Almighty God that He showered us with His great grace and mercy the unknown mysteries of eternal past and revealed their interpretations and meanings to us.

These mysteries are not something that He is revealing to us just for the purpose of adding more facts to our head. Rather, He is revealing to us mysteries that are life changing in so many ways.

We, as Christians, are most blessed above all that the greatest mystery of all concerning the Gospel of Christ has been revealed to us. Listen to the words of the Apostle Paul, "In Him, we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace that He lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding. And He made know to us the muster of His will according to His good pleasure, which He purposed in Christ to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfillment to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ." (Eph.1: 7-10).

According to these verses, it was based upon God's good pleasure to bestow these life saving mysteries to us. Oh, blessed be the name of our Lord. We serve a Great God.

II. Second, God is great because He reveals the future to mankind. (vs. 45). In some of the previous verses and our present verse, we are told over and over that in this particular dream which He gave to King Nebuchadezzar, is showing things that are yet to happen. For the prophet Daniel and the king, most of the events of the dream were yet to happen. However, for us today, a big portion of the dream has already happened.

Yet there is one portion that hasn't and it is the future to all of us, and it is a doozey.

So, here's the one thing that we can rejoice in and declare our God that He is the great God and that is that He has not left us in the dark concerning the future. God's people need to understand He has never meant for us to be clueless about what is yet to come. As a matter of fact, He's been revealing the future since the beginning. We could go from one event to another throughout God's Holy Word and see that much of those events were prophesied before they even happened.

Our God wants us to be informed so that we can make whatever necessary preparations and decisions we need to make based upon what is going to take place.

The apostle John, under the leadership of the Spirit of God, opens up the Book of Revelation by saying, "The revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show His servants <u>what must soon take place</u>. He made it known by sending His angel to His servant John. (Rev. 1:1).

Now, in this same chapter God said to John, "Write, therefore, what you have seen, what is now and what will take place later." (Rev. 1:19). What this verse shows us is that God is the God of the past, the present and the future. Oh, blessed be our Lord that we know how it will turn out.

One thing is for sure, you can know with certainty your future and this is it, if you commit yourself to Christ, you will spend eternity with Jesus in glory. However, if you reject Him, we also know your future, you will spend eternity in Hell. So, shore up your future by repenting and trusting Christ.

III. Third, God is great because He declares the truth to mankind.

(vs. 45). Daniel told the king that the dream and its' interpretation was true. Well, anyone could challenge that easily by showing that it did not come to fruition.

However, the truth of it was verified by the fact that the king had never shared his dream with Daniel. Yet Daniel was able to relay back to the king exactly what his dream was in every detail. Therefore, the ability to give the king his dream lets us know that God gave to them and God gives to us in His Word the truth. My next point will also further demonstrate the accuracy of this point.

Before, however, we go to the next point, let me share what the apostle Paul says about this point. "What if some did not have faith? Will their lack of faith mollify God's faithfulness? Not at all! Let God be true and everyman a liar. As it is written: So that you may be proved right when you speak and prevail when you judge." (Ro. 3:3-4). Only truly God is true.

IV. Fourth, God is great because He fulfills His Word to mankind. (vs. 45). The prophet Daniel stated concerning the dream and interpretation of King Nebuchadnezzar that it not only was true, but was also trustworthy, and he meant by that, that you can bank on it, that it will be absolutely fulfilled as the prophet stated it.

In the last point one of the clear reasons we knew that the dream and interpretation was true was because Daniel under God's leadership was able to reveal to the king what his dream was. However, there is much more that we can point to that will also prove that the dream is true, and will be absolutely fulfilled.

It is the fact that a big portion of the dream and interpretation has already been fulfilled exactly as revealed. Each kingdom that followed the previous kingdom were exactly the very ones the dream represent years in advance.

However, we know that the kingdom representing the feet and toes has not yet taken place. But since the other portions of the dream nave come to pass as predicted, we can be assured the last kingdom represented by the feet and toes will come to pass. So, blessed be to our God who is the great God who doesn't leave usin the dark about the past, present or future. He will bring all of His prophesies and promises without a doubt to fulfillment. So, we should never be surprised when we see God's Word being fulfilled.

Concl. The revelation of his dream and its' interpretation caused the great King Nebuchadnezzar of the Babylonian Kingdom to acknowledge the greatness of our God by declaring Him to be "...the God of gods and the Lord of kings and a revealer of mysteries..." (vs.47).

So, if a pagan king who believed in many gods was willing to acknowledge that God is great because God revealed his dream, how much more should we who have seen God do even so much more, mainly the fulfillment of our Savior coming into the world to save us. My prayer is that the Holy Spirit will implant in our hearts the greatness of our God.


