

The Whole Story

Intro: How many times do we make judgments before we have the whole story, or sometimes we make bad or wrong decisions because we don't have the whole story. It is important that we get the complete picture in order that we can make the right judgments or decisions. Well, this Easter Sunday we've been given the whole story.

# <u>I. First, we are encouraged to preach the whole story. (Acts 20:26-27).</u>

In these two verses, the Apostle Paul is giving a farewell speech to a group of pastors. He is trying to encourage them to do as he had done with them.

So, what was that he had done with them" "therefore, I declare to you today that I am innocent of the blood of all men. For I have not hesitated to proclaim to you the whole will of God." He preached to them the whole will of God and her therefore was encouraging them to do the same.

### II. Second, we need to know the whole story. (I Cor. 15:1-8).

Now, you can't preach the whole story if you don't know the whole story. Now, there is no way we could in this short message give the whole story of the entire Bible. But on this Easter Weekend, we can give the whole story of how Jesus provided us our redemption in a nutshell. "For what I received I assed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures and that He appeared to Peter, and then to the twelve. After that, He appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers at the

same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep. Then He appeared to James, then to all the Apostles, and last of all He appeared to me also, as to one abnormally born." (I Cor. 15:3-8).

So, our redemption is not complete with just the cross and His burial. The whole story includes the Resurrection and without it you don't have the whole story. The Resurrection is God's verification of the work He did at the cross.

### III. Third, you need to experience the whole story. (Col. 2:9-10).


The whole and complete works that Jesus did mentioned in the last point do not become a reality in our lives until we receive Christ into our hearts and lives ourselves. Only in Him will we be made whole and complete. "For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, and you have been given fullness in Christ, who is the head over every power and authority." (Col. 9-10).

Concl. So, today cry out to Christ for the forgiveness of your sins because He alone has done everything required to redeem us. He is the whole story and in Him we too can be made complete and whole in the sight of Almighty God.


