The Answer to Daniel's Prayer (Part IV)
(Dan. 9:20-27)

Intro: today, we will examine the last point of our message dealing with the answer to Daniel's prayer. In this message our focus will be the last part of the plan that we began looking at last week. In that message, we noted that the plan found in the answer to Daniel's prayer had a starting point and had a long section. Today's message will cover the final part of the plan revealed in these last couple of verses which will reveal to us what is going to take place in the final week of years or as we have learned means seven years. So, we are examining the final seven years of the 490 years which will complete the prophecy found in the answer to Daniel's prayer.

VII.c. The last part of the plan found in the answer to Daniel's prayer in the final part of the plan.

In verse 24 in a previous message, we saw that God had promised that by the end of the 490 years six things or six promises would be fulfilled. Well, so far we've looked at already 483 years of the prophecy and those six promises have not yet been fulfilled. Therefore this final set of seven years will be the time period in which God will cause those six promises to be completely fulfilled.

Now, last week we looked at when God hit the start button on the stop watch to begin the 70 weeks of years 490 years so that we could verify the accuracy of His prophecy to Daniel. It began March 14, 445 BC when King Artaxerxes issued the decree to Nehemiah that he could go back to Jerusalem to rebuild the city wall, streets and trenches in the city.

However, on April 6, 32 AD, exactly 483 years later or 69 weeks of years on the day Jesus made His triumphal entrance into Jerusalem, God hit the pause button leaving one more weeks of years, the 70th week to yet be fulfilled. During this long pause period of the 490 years God is reaching out to the Gentiles, offering to them the message of Salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ who sacrificed Himself on the cross for us. It is called the church age, the age of grace. During this time, Jesus is creating a bride for Himself which is the church. The church is everybody that is genuinely saved.

However, when the last Gentile is saved during this pause period, the church will be raptured out. So, is this automatically when the final seven years will begin? Will this be when God hits the start button one more time to complete the final set of seven years, the 70th week of this prophecy is the answer to Daniel's prayer?

Well, the answer to the question is no, the rapture does not necessarily initiate the final seven years in the prophecy. So, if the rapture does not necessarily start those final 7 years, then what does? The good news is that the prophecy again does not leave us hanging as to when will the final week-The 70th week, or the final 7 years begin/

Now, what we are told is that the final 7 years will begin the moment when, "He will confirm a covenant with many for one seven..." (vs. 27). Well, this leaves us with more questions, and those questions are who is he and with whom is he signing a covenant with?

Again, these verses gives us the answer to these questions. First, we know who the people are that he is confirming a covenant with. It is the nation of Israel. The reason we know this is because the prophecy is all about what God is going to do with the nation of Israel. Also, further in this verse in which we find a person confirming a covenant with Israel, we see that this person who signs a covenant with Israel will desecrate their temple. So, we understand that receiver of the covenant is Israel.

Now, that leaves us to answer who is he that is going to confirm a covenant with Israel? So, we find part of our answer back in verse 26. One of the things that we saw in our last message was that when God hits the pause button after 483 years of the 490 years are completed, two things would happen. The first was the Anointed One would be cut off. This was referring to the crucifixion of Christ.

Now, the second thing that would happen would be that, "The people of the ruler who will come will destroy the city and the sanctuary..." Jesus made this prophecy as well after the Jews rejected Him as their Messiah. He told them that the city of Jerusalem would be completely destroyed including the temple. It would be destroyed beyond recognition, and the people of the ruler who will come that destroyed the city and the sanctuary were the Romans. In 70 AD, the Romans came and completely ravaged the city and took its' citizens into exile where they were scattered everywhere.

So, when it says, "He will confirm a covenant with many for one seven, "it is referring back to the ruler in the previous verses who will come. So, that lets us know that the ruler who is to come will be the leader or ruler of a revised Roman Empire. Now, from chapter two and seven, we've already discovered that the final kingdom that5 will rule over most of the know world will be a revised Roman Empire and it will be controlled by one prominent leader. Most Biblical scholars are in agreement that this leader is the Antichrist.

Therefore, the last seven years of the 490 years will begin the moment that the Antichrist signs with Israel. With this covenant he will promise to protect the people of Israel from their enemies all around them. He will also allow them to rebuild their temple and re-institute their sacrificial sacrifices at the temple.

However, half way through, he, the Antichrist will put a stop to their way of worship at the temple and will instead declare himself to be their Messiah, their God. He set up some kind of idol or object in the temple that represents him and will demand that everyone everywhere will worship him. If they fail to do so they will be either martyred or greatly persecuted by him. He will set up a one world government. He will make you take the mark of the beast in order to get anything that is necessary to survive. To refuse this mark will lead to persecution and death.

However, praise be to our God that our last verse that we are examining here does not end with what the Antichrist does when he sets himself up to be the Messiah himself. Now, thank our God there is more to the verse and the more is that God is going to bring our end to the Antichrist and his terror. For in this verse's last statement says, "until the end that is decreed is poured out on him." (vs. 27). What this means is that at the end of the last 7 years, God will send back Jesus Christ His son for His second coming at which time He will put an end to the antichrist.

Now, when this event happens, the nation of Israel will see Christ as their Messiah and they will believe in Him completely. When they do then all 6 promises God made in verse 2 will come to a completion and the 490 will have been fulfilled. All one has to do to learn more of this is to study the Book of Revelation. From chapter 4 through the end of the Book it is all about these last seven years in which God will culminate all He said He would do with the nation of Israel,, and we know He will because of the other part of the prophecy that is already been fulfilled.

Concl. So, where will the church be during this seven years of tribulation? We will be in glory with our Lord who will come and rapture us out. Take time to read I Cor. 15:50-57 and I Thess. 4:13-18. but just know that if you aren't saved when Jesus comes to take His church out of this world, you will be left behind to go into the great tribulation period. So don't delay, cry out to Christ today in repentance and faith.
