

Paul's Message to the Athenians (Acts 17:16-34)

#### **Introduction:**

In our previous message we examined Jesus' witness to the Samaritan woman. We noticed that this was a great example of how our Lord used the opportunities that were at hand as a means of sharing salvation with a lost soul.

In our present message I want us to tak notice of the Apostle Paul following the example of Jesus our Lord by also taking advantage of the opportunities that presented themselves to him as well.

The specific example we are looking at is the time He went to Athens. While he was there he had the opportunity to preach to what may have been a fairly large crowd in a very distinguished place, the Areopagus.

However, the privilege to be able to preach at the Areopagus didn't start at the Areopagus. It rather began in the market place where the people carried out their everyday living. That's where he began his witnessing, in the midst of life as usual for the Athenians.

Which then opened the door to preach to the larger audience at the Areopagus. So when we take advantage of the opportunities that present themselves to us in the market place of life it can open up even greater opportunities. So let's take a look at Paul's message the Athenians as a great example of taking advantage of the opportunities at hand as a means of witnessing.

# I. First, Paul's message to the Athenians began with the place where they were and the people they were (verse 2:2)

Paul started his message by saying, "Men of Athens!" He spoke those three words from knowledge he had gained from others about the men of Athens. But more importantly he spoke to them from the experience he had while he was personally moving around their city, and witnessing in their market place.

Paul discovered that indeed Athens was all that it had always been advertised as. It was known for hundreds of years as the cultural and educational centers of the known world. It produced the most well known philosophers the world had ever known such as Socrates, Plato, Aristotle, Epicurus, Zeno, and many more.

So what Paul encountered while moving about in their market place were a lot of philosophical debates taking place. As well there was a lot of discussion concerning religion. Over the years Athens had created so many idols of so-called gods that some of their writers said Athens had more gods than it had humans. As a matter of fact they even made an alter with the inscription, "to an unknown God." (verse 23). This was just in case they missed one.

So Paul began his message right where the people of Athens were and who they were. By stating that they were the men of Athens he was honoring them as men well educated, philosophical, and religious. He also began with one of their own religious altars, the one to the unknown God, to ultimately share the message of salvation to them.

Just the other day at the hospital Mack Pope and I were waiting for an elevator to come up. The elevator right next to that one was being worked on. So we struck up a conversation with the man working on it. I started my conversation with him by using the business that he was in I said to him, you're in the business of moving people up and down. Then I said, I'm in the business of just moving them up because I'm a preacher. He laughed and said, that's good.

So once again let us observe and listen for where people are and who they are so that we can grab their attention by starting our conversation with them from their point of view, to move them to where they need to be.

# II. Second, Paul's message to the Athenians was to give them the proclamation they needed to understand.

What Paul is going to show the Athenian is that with all their education, their philosophy, their religion, and their idols they had not yet been able to settle on just exactly who God is. It was for this reason that they created the altar to the unknown God.

Now with Paul's own personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ, and his knowledge of the word of God he could definitely give the Athenians the exact knowledge and understanding of who the unknown God was and is. This is an important reminder to us that if the world is going to know just who God is then it must come from God's word. For man's education, philosophies, and religions are tainted by our sin nature. But the word of God is infallible and inerrant because God gave it to us.

Now the knowledge of God that Paul revealed to them is the awesome view of just how Almighty out God is. He revealed that God is the creator of all things. He's the self-existing on not requiring the assistance of anyone to exist. He's the giver of life, and the sustainer of life. For every breath we breathe He gave to us, and gives it to us. He is sovereignly in control of the universe.

Next Paul reveals something that is absolutely incredible about God, and that is that though He's all the amazing things we just wrote about, He is also knowable. Our awesome God can be known intimately and personally. As a matter of fact, it's His desire that we know Him. Listen to Paul's words. "God did this so that men would seek Him and perhaps reach out for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us." (verse 27).

Next Paul reveals to the men of Athens not only who God is but who they are. First, he revealed the simple fact that mankind is definitely, not God. For God is the creator but we are the created. God needed no one to exist but we needed Him to exist. Paul taught that God only created one human race not many. For we all come from one man, (Adam was the first man) and his wife Eve. While there is one human race, there are may different people groups. Thus, this makes each individual human accountable to God because we are all one race.

The next thing Paul showed them about mankind was that though they were created by God they were separated from Him. He showed that they were separated from Him because of their sin. Particularly their sin of making God out to be a worthless idol made from mankind's own hands. Finally, Paul showed them that because of their sinful ways that one day they would face God for judgment.

However, the glorious news is that even though mankind had sinned against Him God still desired to have a relationship with them. And in our next point we will see how God made it possible for this to happen.

# III. Third, Paul's message to the Athenian revealed the procedure that they need to follow

In other words Paul revealed to them what they needed to do in order to have a relationship with God. Also to have the sins forgiven and their condemnation taken away.

So what was the procedure they needed to follow? First, Paul tells them that they must repent of their sins. And this command was not for a select few, or for a particular people group, or for the people who appear to be the worst among us. No, rather this command is for each one of us, because it was addressed for all people everywhere.

To repent means to acknowledge our sinfulness and have a willingness to turn from it. But this alone will not restore our relationship to God. We must move to the next step in the procedure we need to follow in order to restore our relationship to God.

So as we noted Paul first tells them to repent. Repentance is turning away. But as we turn away from sin we need to turn toward something or I should say someone. Paul cries out for them to move in faith and commitment toward the risen and exalted Savior Jesus Christ, He alone can forgive sin, redeem the lost and restore them to an eternal relationship with God.

The knowable God can be known through Christ and Christ alone.

#### **Conclusion:**

We have much a glorious message to share. So let's get out there in the market place of life and share this glorious good news!




