Reasons for the Plot to Kill Jesus (John 11:45-57)

Introduction:

From this time until Easter I'm going to lead us on a journey through many of the things that happened to Jesus during His last week here on earth right up through His crucifixion and resurrection. My primary source for this journey will be the Gospel of John because much of John reveals the events that took place during Jesus' last week here on earth.

However, to begin this journey we are going to look at an event that happened in Jesus' life just prior to His last week. Jesus has resurrected Lazarus from the dead, and some of those who were an eye witness to Lazarus' resurrection have reported to the Pharisees what has happened. The Pharisees are so bothered by this news that they go and report it to the Sanhedrin. The Sanhedrin, which is the Jewish Religious Authority in Israel, made up of 70 men, call for a counsel meeting to deal with this news of Lazarus's resurrection. The result of the meeting was a desire and plot to kill Jesus. So what I want us to see in this message are the reasons why the Sanhedrin plotted to kill Jesus.

I. The first reason the Sanhedrim plotted to kill Jesus was because of who He was.

What prompted the Sanhedrin to call a council meeting was to address what they were going to do with Jesus because he had resurrected Lazarus from the dead. Now the significance of this is that what this means is that those who saw the miracle and reported it to the Sanhedrin, and the Sanhedrin itself, who all believed that only God can raise the dead are therefore angry with Jesus because He is God.

Now they're not out right saying that Jesus is God but they can't deny the resurrection that has just happened for two reasons: First, Lazarus, who laid in the grave for four days can be produced. Second, because there were many eye witnesses to Lazarus's resurrection. As a matter of fact it was some of these eye witnesses that relayed the information to the Sanhedrin. Plus, the Sanhedrin doesn't deny it and declares that He's performed many other miracles.

So the point I am making is that by their own admission that Jesus had done this miracle and many more, they are saying that Jesus is God, though they deny it. So they are plotting to kill Jesus because He really is who He's claimed to be all along, God.

This is what much of John's Gospel is all about showing that Jesus is indeed and in fact fully God. It begins with Jesus as the word of God who also was God. Then with many other expressions it continues to declare this message of Jesus Deity. In this gospel Jesus is called the Lamb of God; the Bread of life; the Living Water; the Resurrection and the Life; the Son of God; the Way, the Truth and the Life; and the list goes on.

Now a very important lesson to learn is that miracles are not necessarily going to convince someone to become a believer in Jesus Christ. For some of the very ones who actually witnessed Lazarus's resurrection not only didn't believe in Him, but also ran off to report the message to the Pharisees to help them do something about Jesus.

People have often said if Jesus would only do this or that then they would believe in Him. Usually they are referring to some magnificent miracle such as Lazarus's resurrection.

However today we don't need to be looking for great miracles to convince ourselves and the lost world that Jesus was and is God. The reason why is because God's word has already revealed to us that Jesus did magnificent miracles when He walked among us.

Thus, the most important tool to use to convince people that Jesus is God and therefore should be believed on as God and as our Lord and Savior is God's Holy Word.

Jesus tells the story of another man named Lazarus and his connection to a rich man. Lazarus was poor and begged the rich man just for his crumbs but would not give them to him. Eventually they both died. Lazarus wound up in Abraham's bosom but the rich man ended up in hell.

The rich man was able to speak to Father Abraham. He asked Abraham to send someone back from the grave to convince his brother not to end up in hell like he did. However, Jesus said that Abraham replied by saying, "They have Moses and the prophets, let them listen to them. No. Father Abraham he said but if someone from the dead goes to them they will repent. He said do not listen to Moses and the prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead" (Luke16:39-31).

So let us keep right on preaching, teaching, and sharing God's word if we want to help sinners believe in Jesus Christ as God who alone can save us.

Oh by the way because they were plotting to kill Jesus for who He was then they're plotting was doomed to failure from the get go.

II. The second reason the Sanhedrin plotted to kill Jesus was because of what He could do.

Now this at first may sound like I'm doing a repeat of my first point. However I will make a distinction between this point and the previous one.

The Sanhedrin was made up of 70 men. These 70 men were made up primarily of two specific religious sects, the Sadducees and the Pharisees. The two groups had some vastly different theologies concerning their religious beliefs. One of the main differences was that the Pharisees believed in the resurrection of the dead while the Sadducees didn't. However, when it came to Jesus despite their differences these two groups were willing to work together to get rid of Jesus. It's ironic that both groups wanted to get rid of Jesus because of the fact that He did raise the dead.

The Sadducees were angry because right in the midst where they live and do their work at the Sanhedrin Jesus so powerfully resurrected Lazarus from the dead in front of many witnesses. So that event could not be clarified as a fraud. How dare Jesus come into their domain and challenge their preaching, their message, and their theology.

Their theology continues sadly right on down to our times and even in our so-called churches where they want to deny the power of Christ, and deny the miracles He performed, and deny Him as the creator, and deny His deity.

Paul tells us to watch out for those who, "having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with such people." (2 Tim 3:5).

Once again their plot to kill Jesus will fail because Jesus has the power to lay His life down and the power to raise it up again (John 10:18). So they can deny His power all day long but that won't stop it.

III. The third reason the Sanhedrin plotted to kill Jesus was because He was not one of theirs.

This point is not as much about theology like the two previous points. Rather this point is about the personal and selfish motives of the Sanhedrin. In their minds they had to kill Jesus because He was going to cause them to lose their authority, influence, employment, prosperity, property, and their way of life.

Now the way they addressed this was to say that Jesus will cause them to lose their place and their nation. Now when they say their place many scholars believe that they are referring to the temple. However, other scholars believe that they are referring to their place in Sanhedrin. I think that it's both: the temple and their position in the Sanhedrin.

Really however what it's all about is that Jesus has got to go because He's interfering with their way of life and tragically that's how so many people see Jesus today that He's interfering with their way of living and He's got to go so to speak.

But as Jesus prophesied a little later of the destruction of Jerusalem including its walls and temple, it had nothing to do with Jesus. Rather 40 years later Rome came and completely destroyed Jerusalem and the nation of Israel because of their rebellion. However because Jesus was and is God and because he can save the dead He was able, back in 1948, to resurrect the nation of Israel back into existence. Blessed be the name of our amazing Lord!

IV. The fourth reason why the Sanhedrin plotted to kill Jesus was because His death could save them.

Back during the time that Jesus walked on earth there were many rebellious Jews called zealots who rebelled against Rome's control over Israel. These zealots always made the Sanhedrin nervous because they were fearful Rome would send an army to squash the nation.

Caiaphas the high priest at the time and leader over the Sanhedrin, saw the plot to kill Jesus as their golden opportunity to end the threat of the Romans destroying the entire nation by giving to Rome the one main person who was according to them was Rome's real threat and if they could turn Him over to Rome then they would kill him but spare the nation. So Caiaphas was saying that by Jesus's death the rest of the nation would be saved. He meant saved from destruction.

However God intended that His words meant something far more valuable than Caiaphas even understood. God was leading him to say these words as a true prophecy that Jesus was going to die not only for the nation of Israel but also for all that would ever trust in Him for eternal salvation and the Sanhedrin wasn't aware that God was even in control of what they were planning to do. For God had already determined in eternity past that the way He was going to save us was by the means of the crucifixion.

Conclusion:

So let us remember what Joseph told his brothers who had brutally harmed and mistreated him. He said to them, "You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives." (Gen. 50:20). So what the Sanhedrin meant for harm God meant for our salvation. Oh, what a savior we have!
