

The Ministry of Reconciliation (2 Cor 5:18-21)

Introduction:

The Word of God leaves us no doubt whatsoever that the worst consequence of our sins is complete and total separation from God. Here are a few of the verses that reveal this truth. "For the wages of sin is death..." (Romans 6:23). "As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins." (Eph 2:1). "Once you were alienated from God, and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior." (Col 1:21)

The Bible is also quite clear that apart from intervention on our behalf we would remain in a place of eternal separation from God, which of course is what hell is. "Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. The lake of fire is the second death. If anyone's name was not found written in the Book of Life, he was thrown into the lake of fire." (Rev 20:14, 15). It's the place of eternal condemnation.

To further demonstrate how serious this consequence of our sin is is to point out the fact that we ourselves personally are incapable of bringing about our own individual reconciliation to God. Because the verses we mentioned above reveal the fact that because of our sins we are dead spiritually to God already. So because we are already dead spiritually before our holy God, we are ruled out of fixing this matter.

However, praise be to our God where as we are incapable of fixing this matter by our own human efforts God has given to us the ministry of reconciliation. This ministry reveals how mankind can be reconciled back to our amazing holy God. So let's examine this ministry of reconciliation and get excited about it and motivated by it.

I. First, let's notice that the ministry of reconciliation is a divine ministry.

These verses that we are looking at begins with this phrase, "All this is from God..." (vs 18). Now that phrase has to do with the verse before it and what follows it. In the verse that came before it, Paul reveals the fact that in Christ God makes us a new creation. Thus He gives to us new life. With this new creation and new life, He has removed our spiritual death, and reconciled us unto Himself.

Thus, we don't have to throw in the towel and give up on reconciliation taking place. For though reconciliation is something we can't achieve, our God from whom we are separated can achieve. And He not only can but has achieved it for us.

These verse therefore are telling us that reconciliation is 100% the work of God. It's what He desired. It's what He wanted. And it's what He alone made possible. As a matter of fact, the whole blessed Trinity was and is in the work of reconciliation. The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit works in cooperation to bring about mankind's privilege of being reconciled to God. He's the one who desires, calls out, appeals, pleads for, and brings about our reconciliation.

The world works in just the opposite manner. From the world's perspective, the one who offends must in some manner make up to the offended one. But with God it was the offended who made it possible for the offender to get right with Him.

Listen to how Pastor Allen Redpath, who is now with the Lord, describes this thought: "I would stand in awe and worship, in reverent amazement. Here is God the omnipotent, pleading Almighty God our fortress, our deliverer, our strength, to whom the nations are but drops in the bucket, who has all power in heaven and earth, committed to Him—pleading! Surely this plea for the love of another, this begins for an enemy would put away his enmity, is the part of the one who is the inferior, the one who has offended, the offender rather than the offended. It is the place of the rebel — not the king, to plead. But here in Deity is the person of God in Jesus Christ breaking through all the patterns of human relationships and human precedents; here God omnipotent in heaven bending down to this little planet in which there is total rebellion against His rule, and saying to the rebel race who lie helpless at His feet, 'I beg you to be reconciled to God.'"

So therefore let us not loose hope of never gaining reconciliation with God. Rather let us embrace the reconciliation God has made possible.

II. Second, the ministry of reconciliation is a declared ministry.

Though reconciliation is 100% the work of God, He has chosen His people as the means or vehicle by which He declares the message of reconciliation to this lost and dying world. For these verses are very clear on this point. For they tell us that God, "...gave us the ministry of reconciliation" (vs 18). "And He has committed to us the message of reconciliation" (vs 19). "We are therefore Christ ambassadors" (vs 20).

God's choice for us to be His means of declaring His message does not give us the authority or power to declare just any message we choose to. For we are very clearly His ambassador which means we exclusively represent Him and no one else. Thus, our message must be exactly the message that He gives to us.

A Bible scholar from the past named Hodge describes adequately the role of an ambassador of heaven. "An ambassador is at once a messenger and a representative. He does not speak in his own name. He does not act on his own authority. What he communicates is not his own opinions or demands but simply what he has been told or commanded to say. But at the same time he speaks with authority, in this case the authority of Christ Himself."

So if we want the lost to know about the saving message of reconciliation then we've got to tell them. For we alone are His representatives in this world.

III. Third, the ministry of reconciliation is a decisive ministry.

Now what I'm referring to on this point is that we are given one message to declare and it's decisive. In other words it's the only message that can reconcile a person unto God. No other message will do.

So what is this decisive message? Well, we stated in the first point that the ministry of reconciliation was and is a divine ministry. We pointed out that God is the one who desires for the lost to be reconciled to Him, and God is the one who appealing for the lost to be reconciled to Him. We also made the point that He's the one who made it possible for mankind to be reconciled to Him.

So in the last verse that we are looking at it shows how God made reconciliation possible. Our sins separate us from God so it is our sins that must be dealt with if we are going to be reconciled. Thus God took His pure, sinless, and holy Son and laid on Him the sin of us all. He then took the punishment of those sins for us. In exchange for those who choose to believe in Him their sins are removed while Jesus righteousness is bestowed upon them. So that when the Father looks at us positionally He sees the righteousness of His Son in us and not our sins.

A very familiar prophesy in the Book of Isaiah gives us a very powerful picture of this verse we are looking at in this point. "Surely He took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered Him stricken by God, smitten by Him, and afflicted. But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon Him, and by His wounds we are healed. We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the Lord laid on Him the iniquity of us all" (Is 53:4-6).

So we have a very decisive message but what an amazing one it is. There's not another one out there to compare to it. And there's not another one that can reconcile you unto God but this one. Because God is the one who made it happen.

Conclusion:

Sometimes ambassadors are required to share a message with the nation they are sent to that will do anything but draw the countries closer together. Sometimes their message can cause a riff, or even a war. But thanks be unto our God that the message we share as ambassadors is the message that if heeded will totally and completely reconcile those to whom we are sent unto our God.




