

From Pastor Ralph's Desk:



Evil Will Not Prevail (2 Chronicles 22:10-23:21)

Introduction:

From the looks of things in our world one would conclude tht evil is prevailing, and it seems as though we are at a point at which it cannot be reversed. For as it was in the days of the prophet Isaiah who said of his time on earth, "Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who put darkness for light and light for darkness, who put bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter." (Is 5:20). This is exactly where we are in our times We have become so evil that good is now evil, light is now dark, and sweet is now bitter.

Of course Biblically we understand that Satan is behind all of this evil, and with all of this evil he wants to do everything that he can to prevent the name of Jesus Christ our Lord from being uplifted and exalted in our world. He even wants to use all of this evil to do all that he can to prevent the second coming of Christ from taking place as he attempted to prevent the first coming of Christ taking place. However, we need to know and be reminded that ultimately evil will not prevail. In our present set of verses we have an example of where evil attempted to prevail by ultimately trying to kill off the Davidic line which God had promised to King David that he would always have a descendant who would rule over Israel forever. But in this story all attempts fail. And all attempts will always fail because there's always God. So let's see how these set of verses teach us that evil will not prevail.

I. First, from this set of verses we learn that evil will not prevail because God's power is supreme.

In this set of verses the evil person is a lady named Athaliah. She's the mother of King Ahaziah who reigns over the nation of Judah. Her son Ahaziah has been killed, and she decides tht she wants to reign and rule over the nation herself for she was originally from the nation of Israel and daughter of the most wicked king they had, King Ahab, and she desires to make Judah just like Israel. A nation where wickedness and evil reigned.

Now in order to accomplish her goal she must destroy the royal line of the Davidic ancestors. So she attempts to kill off all of her son's other brothers so that they can't rise up to the throne. However, her attempt fail short because she was coming up against the power of Almighty God. She seemed to have the upper hand until she encountered the hand of God.

Every Athaliah, or Hitler, or Stalin have attempted by their power to stamp out the presence of Christ in our world. But every time they ultimately fail because the run square into the Almighty awesome person of our eternal God. The Apostle Paul reminds us that all other authorities and power are subject to Jesus Christ our Lord. "He (Jesus) is the signage of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by Him all things were created: Things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by Him and for Him. He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together." (Col. 1:15-17)

So just know that evil will not prevail because it will always have to come against the sovereign power of Almighty God.

II. Second, from these set of verses we learn that evil will not prevail because God's purpose can't be stopped.

Now as we learned in the first point Athaliah had one primary purpose to stop the royal line from succeeding to the throne because she wanted that for herself and the evil ways of the northern kingdom of Israel.

However God's purpose was that the royal line would succeed and continue for the coming of Christ into our world so that He could take upon Himself the flesh of the family and linage of King David.

Even though Athaliah failed in her attempt to stop the royal line of David Satan continued to try and put a stop to that linage even up to and beyond Christ's birth through people like Herod and many others. But all attempts have failed and will fail because God's plans and purposes will always succeed.

The Word of God assures us over and over that God's plans and purposes always prevail. "Then Job replied to the Lord; I know that you can do all things; no plan of yours can be thwarted." (Job 42:1, 2)

"The Lord foils the plans of the nations; He thwarts the purposes of the peoples. But the plans of the Lord stand firm forever, the purposes of His heart through all generations." (Ps 33:10, 11)

"Remember the former things, those of long ago; I am God and there is no other. I am God and there is none like me. I make known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come. I say: My purpose will stand and I will do all that I please. From the east I summon a bird of prey; from a far off land, a man to fulfill my purpose, what I have said that I will bring about; what I have planned, that I will do." (Is 46:9-11)

III. Third, from these set of verses we learn that evil will not prevail because God's promises are satisfied.

I mean by this that God's promises are fulfilled. Athaliah was not only going against the power and purpose of God but she also was going against His promise. At the time that Athaliah was attempting to kill off the royal line and instill herself as Judah's leader she was unaware of the fact that a lady named Jehosheba, a daughter of a previous king of Judah, had stole away one of the young sons of the king and hid him for six years in the temple of the Lord.

When the young child turned seven the high priest Jehoiada decided that things were so bad in Judah because of Athaliah evil reign that it was time to produce the young son and declare him to be king over Judah. And he knew that it was the right thing to do because of God's promise that a descendant of David would be upon the throne. SO the priest and the people that he got assembled made a covenant with the king. "The whole assembly made a covenant with the king at the temple of God. Jehoiada said to them, the king's son shall reign, as the Lord promised concerning the descendants of David." (Isaiah 23:3)

Well, because of God's promise, the king's son Joash was lifted upon the throne and Athaliah was destroyed. God's promises can never be broken. Once again the Bible is filled with references that are clear that God keeps His promises. "God is not a man that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should change His mind." (Number 23:19)

"Not one of all the Lord's good promises to the house of Israel failed; everyone was fulfilled." (Joshua 21:45)

"But as surely as God is faithful, our message to you is not yes and no. For the son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by me and Silas and Timothy, was not yes and no but in Him it's always been yes. For no matter how many promises God has made, they are yes in Christ. And so through Him the amen is spoken by us to the glory of God.' (II Cor 1::19, 20).

Ultimately Jesus fulfills the promise. He's the descendant of David who will reign over the home of Israel as well as the entire kingdom of God forever and ever. And all the evil in the world and all the forces of hell can't stop it from happening, praise God!

Conclusion:

So understanding that evil will not prevail, but that God will and has, have you chosen to be on the prevailing side by repenting of your sins and trusting in the Lord Jesus Christ and His work on Calvary on our behalf and believing in His resurrection for your salvation?
