

Walking Worthy of Your Calling, Part 3 (Eph 4:1-16)

Introduction:

As we continue our series of messages on walking worthy of your calling, we recall that we walk worthy of our calling because we have a cause. We walk worthy of our calling through certain conducts. We walk worthy of our calling with a specific confession, and in this message we will notice that we walk worthy of our calling by our contributions.

IV. Fourth, we walk worthy of our calling through our contributions (vs 7-16).

Usually when someone uses the term contribution they are referring to financial contributions. However for our message we are looking at the contributions of our time, talents, gifts, and service rendered to our blessed Lord Jesus Christ. The Apostle Paul refers to these kind of contributions throughout his writings, and on each of these occasions he basically lays out the same format concerning our usage of them. So we will take a look at what he has to say about our contributions.

A. First, let's notice the personal level of our contributions (vs 7).

Paul here is informing us that not one of God's children can claim that they can't serve in their local church because they lack any kind of gift, skill, or talent to do so. Because Paul under the Holy Spirit's leadership says, "But to <u>each one of us</u> grace has been given as Christ apportioned it." (vs 7).

Now someone might say that that verse says nothing about gifts or talents or skills but only about grace. And so that person would be correct but what kind of grace is being referred to here in this verse?

So there's no doubt whatsoever that for the people of God saving grace has fully and freely been given to them. Grace as the old hymn says that is greater than all of our sins.

However the context in which this verse is written show that the grace apportioned to us here is not primarily about saving grace but rather the grace that God has extended to us when He gave to us spiritual gifts that we could use to serve Him with.

In our set of verses the specific grace gifts that Paul is referring to is the gifted leader that God has gifted the church with. However, in Paul's letter to the Corinthians he reminds us that God gifted us all with some kind of spiritual gift to be used for the benefit of the body of Christ. "The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all of its' parts are many, they form one body." (I Cor 12:12). Now this is what I call unity in diversity. As we begin our new

year God wants Great Swamp Baptist Church to be united by diversity meaning that we all belong to this particular body of believers and we each must use the gifts, talents, abilities, and time that God has graced us each with then the body can function as a whole.

<u>B. Second, let's notice the person giving us our</u> <u>contributions (vs 7).</u>

It is Christ Jesus our Lord, "As Christ apportioned it." Christ Jesus has apportioned to us the full measure of saving grace so that we are fully and permanently saved forever. However, He also is the one who has graced us with the gifts, talents, abilities, and time that we have through the means of the Holy Spirit.

Oh, praise be to our precious Lord Jesus Christ that by His marvelous grace He has demonstrated that no one has given and contributed more than He. As the book of Acts tells us that Jesus said, "...It is more blessed to give than to receive." (Acts 20:35). But not only did Jesus say those words but He demonstrated them by giving to us, out of His grace, our salvation and our gifts for service and so much more.

The great preacher John McArthur speaks of this great grace that God through Christ has apportioned to us. "God is gracious because of who He is, not because of who or what we are. His grace is therefore unmerited, unearned, and undeserved. It depends entirely upon the one who gives it, not the one who receives it. Grace is God's self motivated, self centered, self generated sovereign act of giving."

So let us be motivated to use our gifts, talents, abilities, and time because of the one who has bestowed them upon us.

<u>C. Third, let's notice the plan used to bring about our</u> <u>contributions (vs 9, 10).</u>

Now here I'm referring to the plans that Christ enacted in order to make it possible for us to experience His saving grace but also His gifts of grace which our set of verses is talking about.

This plan centers around two words and those words are <u>descended</u> and <u>ascended</u>. We could spend several pages just on these couple of verses that talk of His descent and ascent. However, let me just put it in a nut shell. Christ descended from His home in heaven. He willingly gave up the privileges of His heavenly position, and descended to earth where He humbled Himself and took on a human body and become the lowest form of a human by becoming a servant. He continued his descent to an old rugged cross where He was condemned to die a death so despised by His people. However His descent is not yet finished for He finally descended to a borrowed grave.

Oh, praise God that His plan included another word, the word ascended. He ascended up out of the grave on the third day and then He ascended back to glory to sit in the throne room of heaven interceding on our behalf to our Heavenly Father. And through Christ we by His grace too will one day ascend up out of the grave and up to glory to forever be with Him.

So let us not sit around and think that we don't have to do anything in our churches in light of the marvelous grace Christ has apportioned to us, we've got to get the work considering both His descension and ascension.

Conclusion:

I pray that his message is further motivating all of God's people to be ready with the new church year to step up to the plate and do the part God is calling us to.




