DEACON OF THE WEEK:





Mary's Forever (Luke 1:26-38)

Introduction:

Twice in the 12 verses chosen for this message Mary is told that she is highly favoured. So for this message I want us to examine this favour that Mary received because what we will discover is that her favour also because our favour. This favour makes Christmas such an amazing time of the year because it reminds us that God's favour has resided over us for a long long time.

I. First, Mary's favour came in the form of an appearance (vs 26-29)

The appearance of course was that the angel Gabriel who came to share the announcement with Mary that she had been chosen to bring Christ into the world.

As we can see Mary was completely caught off guard by this appearance. Like the majority of Jews of her day, she certainly believe that the Messiah was coming in her life time. However she certainly couldn't believe that in anyway she would be a part of the plan to make it happen. So once again the appearance of the angel Gabriel was such an unbelievable experience for her to be having.

Now the question is, why she was surprised by this appearance? Well, I'm sure that as we discussed last week one reason is because it was such a sudden appearance which brought about a disruption of life as she knew it. But there are

some very obvious other reason for her surprise that this was happening to her. For there was not any reason that she could possibly see why she would be chosen. She was just an ordinary young Jewish girl of no special renown. She was living in a town that was looked down upon by most. Also she was not even yet fully married so how could she be favoured to receive this appearance and this news?

Well, the only reason for this appearance and the favour that came with it was purely and only by God's amazing grace. Mary didn't have this favour because she was more special than all the other young virgin girls of her day. So Mary's favour rest purely upon who God is not who she was.

So it is with us as well. Those of us who have been favoured and chosen by God has only been because our God is a gracious God. "Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love he predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will -- <u>to the praise</u> of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves." (Eph 1:3-6).

II. Second, Mary's favour came in the form of an announcement (vs 29-33)

Of course the announcement was the news that she will become pregnant and give birth to a son whom she will give the name Jesus. Now in most cases there is no happier news for a young lady than to hear that she is pregnant. So Mary is favoured because she will conceive and be with child and give birth to a son and call Him Jesus.

However this son of Mary was more than just her son. For the angel told Mary that her son also would be the Son of the Most High, the Son of God, and that He would reign on the throne of David and His Kingdom would never end. Thus because He's the Son of God this child though a special favour to Mary, He's also a favour to us all.

"But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy <u>for all the people</u>. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord." (Luke 2:10-11). So this announcement favours us all.

III.Third, Mary's favour came in the form of an answer (vs 34-32)

Well, an answer obviously implies that a question has been asked and anybody who knows the Christmas story knows that the question Mary asked the angel Gabriel was how could she become pregnant since she was a virgin?

Well, the answer to that question once again reveals that Mary was highly favoured as well as all the rest of us. The answer was that in a way unbeknownst to us the Holy Spirit of God through His power miraculously placed the Son of God within the womb of Mary so that He could take upon Himself human flesh.

Well, like Mary it's the work of the Holy Spirit of God that has, by His power, conceived us into the family of God giving us a new birth which could not have happened apart from His work in us. The perfect picture of this is found in the conversation between Jesus and Nicodemus in which Jesus told Nicodemus that He needed to be born again, which could only happen by the work of the Holy Spirit of God.

"Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.' The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit." (John 3:5-8) Oh, the favour that God has shown us that His Spirit works in us to save us and lead us.


IV. Fourth, Mary's favour came in the form of her acceptance (v. 38)

In this verse Mary's favour is that our gracious God has brought He to the place of acceptance of what God has said that He's going to do in her life. This happened by the means of the appearance of the angel Gabriel, and by the means of the announcement He made, and answer he gave, she was fully really to yield to His will and purpose for her life. We too have been highly favoured that God has done what needs to be done to convince us of our acceptance of what He wants to do in our lives. For He has given us His word with the announcement of His coming in it. He has also given us messengers to preach and share that great announcement given to Mary to us, and has poured His Spirit to awaken us to the message. Praise be to our God for His great and gracious favour.

Conclusion:


When the angel finished giving the shepherds the good news of the birth of the Savior the heavens resounded with an angelic choir that was praising God and this is what they were saying, "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those <u>on whom His favour rest.</u>" (Luke 2:13-14). Today that favour can rest on you if you will be willing to yield your life to Him in repentance and faith.


