The Church Still Stands

(Matt 16:13-28)

Introduction:

Tammy and I had an amazing cruise to Iceland, Greenland, and the Canadian coast. Our ship went altogether to eight ports. Five of the eight ports have strong ties to the Viking culture, especially in Newfoundland, Greenland, and Iceland. So we were expecting that when we entered this town we would be seeing and hearing mostly about the Vikings.

However this was not the case. Rather the first thing we were usually advised to do was to go and look at the most well known church that was in town and usually that church was either on the highest hill overlooking the town or in the most central location of the town. They were clearly identifiable and easy to find and get to.

The most impressive one was in Reykjavik, the capital city of Iceland. I couldn't even begin to pronounce the name of the church but it sits on the highest hill in town on the very top of it. You can spot the church from about anywhere in town. Also not only does it sit on the highest point in town but the church itself stands taller than any other building around. It looks like a space ship ready to take off.

Tammy and I paid to ride the elevator all the way up to the bell tower. From there we could see every area of the entire town. It was quite an amazing view from up there.

Now this focus on the churches capturing all the attention in each port town we went to began to lift my spirits in many ways, but for this message especially it reminded me that no matter how much of the past influence the Vikings had over these areas when they were pagan before they had Christian influence it didn't stop the missionaries from coming. And it didn't stop them from building churches and spreading the gospel. And praise be to God these churches still stand and get the greater attention.

So in this message I want to point out that throughout history no matter how many rulers, leaders, cultures have tried to stamp the church out she still stands. She still stands and will stand until Jesus Christ comes to take her home to be with Him. In our scripture text for this message we will examine why and how the church will continue to stand.

I. First, let's notice that the church still stands because Christ is the founder and builder of the church (vs 18)

Now we all know that the conversation taking place is between Jesus our Lord and directly to Peter while the other disciples listened on. So they all were hearing clearly what Jesus was saying directly to Peter.

This conversation they were having began as a discussion as to who exactly Jesus is. The disciples mentioned answers that had been given by different groups of people, but then Jesus asked them point blank who they say that He is. Well, under the leadership of our Heavenly Father, Peter gave the correct answer. Peter said that He was, "the Messiah, the Son of the living God." (vs 16).

Now Jesus assures Peter that his answer is the correct one because His Father had blessed him with this answer. So now knowing that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of the living God, Jesus can now introduce to His disciples the building of the church. For knowing that He is the Messiah, the Son of the living God, they can be assured that the church will indeed come to past, thrive, and last until He's ready to bring it home to be with Him.

As a matter of fact, Jesus directly tells them that, "I," the Messiah, the Son of the living God," will build my church."

Therefore, we all can be assured that because of who He is, and because He's the one who is the founder and builder of the church, it will last the test of time.

Many businesses, industries, companies, nations, and other entities that were once founded and built by great leaders have ceased to exist. But the church will never cease to exist because its founder is none other than "the Messiah, the Son of the living God."

II. Second, let's notice that the church still stands because Christ is the finality and financier of the church (vs 18)

Now what I mean by this is that Jesus founded the church and built the church so that the church would totally belong to Him. As the old saying says, lock, stock, and barrel. He financed it with His own blood and therefore He's the sole, final, and complete owner. As He specifically said to His disciples in our text "...I will build $\underline{\text{My}}$ church and the gates of Hades will not overcome it." (vs 18).

In the book of Acts, Paul speaking to the Ephesians elders to them to "keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseer. Be shepherds of the church of God, which He bought with His own blood." (Acts 20:28).

So because it's His church, lock, stock, and barrel it will stand the test of time absolutely.

III.Third, let's notice that the church still stands because Christ is the foundation of the church. (vs 18).

So we discover in this verse that Jesus declares to Peter that He's going to build His church on a particular rock. As He specifically says, "...on this rock I will build my church." (vs 18).

Now it's no news to anyone that if you are going to build something and you want it to stand against the storms of life then you need to build on a solid rock foundation. When Tammy and I went to the capital city of Greenland called Nuuk we were absolutely amazed that nearly the entire city was built on nothing but virtually rock. As a matter of fact, it appeared as though many of the homes and businesses simply just started building right on top of the rock. We even saw the first house and church that had been there for over 200 or more years ad they were still standing strong.

So we need to answer the questions what particular rock was Jesus referring to? To answer that question we need to remember that Peter's name means a rock. However when Jesus said, "on this rock" He was using a different word for rock then what Peter's name means. Peter's name means small rock whereas the other rock word refers to a massive stone. Now a lot of books have been written about this difference in the words for rock, but when it boils down to it Jesus is ultimately saying that either the declaration that Peter made that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of the living God, is the massive rock. Or that Jesus is saying you are a small rock but My church will be built on a massive rock referring to Himself. However either way it points to the fact that Jesus is the foundation of the church.

Therefore the church will not fail. It will not collapse nor will it cease to be because it's sitting on the surest foundation, this is Jesus Christ, our solid rock. As the old hymn says, "On Christ the solid rock I stand, all other ground is sinking sand."

IV. Fourth, let's notice that the church still stands because Christ is the force of the church (vs 18, 19)

I'm using the word force to represent the power and authority of the church, for the church, and with the church. Three times in these two verses Jesus used the word "I" and each time that He used that word He was instructing Peter and His disciples that I am the one telling you what's going to happen. I'm the one who is going to build my church and the gates of Hades will not overcome it. I'm the one who is going to give you the keys to carry out the work I've given you to do.

So once again Jesus is plainly saying I am the one in control and it's by my power and authority that all of this will get done.

Let me say that if ever we are encouraged to stay with it this should do it. To know that what we are called to do in preaching and proclaiming the gospel to a lost and dying world so that sinners can belong to the church of the living God is backed by and carried out through the power of the Lord Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit of God. Keep on keeping on. Jesus will be with us to empower us.

V. Fifth, let's notice that the church still stands because Christ is the focus and function of the church (vs 19)

Most scholars believe that the basic message of this verse is that the key to the kingdom of heaven is the gospel message and those who respond to the gospel message which we preach will be bound for heaven. However those who reject it will be lost from heaven.


So therefore our focus and function is to take the gospel message of our glorious Lord and Savior Jesus Christ to our lost and dying world. Since it is the calling that our Savior has given for us to do the church will stand until the last sinner is saved and Jesus comes to get His bride the church to come and dwell with Him.

Conclusion:

So because it is totally and completely built by the one whom is the Messiah, the Son of the living God, Jesus Christ our Lord, let us stand tall and boldly proclaim Jesus Christ as our Messiah and as we do we will stand with the test of time through Christ Jesus our Lord.


