



From the Pastor's desk:

The Handiwork of God Ephesians 2:8-10

Introduction:

As we contemplate what God wants us to do this new year then we need to come to grips with what God is teaching us in these verses that I've chosen for this message. Especially is that true with verse ten which focuses on the handiwork of God. So let's see exactly what God's handiwork is so that we can be prepared to face this new year in the manner that God wants us to.

I. First, as we seek to understand God's handiwork, let's notice the persons who are God's handiwork (vs 10)

Anytime you begin a sentence with the word "for" as our verse does you are generally doing so to make a very clear and strong emphasis. Well, that's exactly what is taking place in this verse, and what he is emphasizing is that "we" are God's handiwork.

Now just who was the "we" that the Apostle Paul was referring to? Well, Paul had written this letter of Ephesians to the church and believers that were in Ephesus. So the point is very clear that believers in Christ -- Christians are all the "we" of God's handiwork. So let's ask the question why are Christian's God's handiwork? Well, let's answer that question first by understanding what the Greek word for handiwork is in English. When translated it is the word from which we get the English word poem.

Now a poem doesn't create itself. Rather it takes a poet to give us the poem. The point being that God is the poet and we are His poem. Another way to express it is that He is the master artist and we are His creative masterpiece. Thus clearly pointing out that the only reason why Christians are Christians is because God did all the necessary work to turn us into creative beings both physically and spiritually.

In the first chapter of the bible God creates everything. On each day of creation God would speak into existence what He created on that day. However on day six which was His last day of creating God first created the land animals which again He created by speaking them into existence.

Then however on day six God also chose to create His greatest work of creation human beings. They were the only thing that He chose to create in His image. We were His greatest masterpiece of His creation and to do this masterpiece He didn't just speak us into existence as He did everything else. Rather He became more personally involved. For we are told that God reached down with his hands and scooped up the dust of the earth and formed our bodies. Then with His mouth He breathed into us the breath of life and we became living souls.

However because mankind chose to sin against God then horrible consequences resulted one of such was spiritual death which is separation from God. Thus requiring that we needed a new creation that would restore and reconcile us unto our holy God. And because we are spiritually dead we are incapable of bringing about that new creation.

However praise be to God that through His glorious Son the Lord Jesus Christ He did all the work required to bring about this new creation in our lives. Once again He's the master artist who did the whole work from beginning to end to make his new piece of art that is well pleasing in His sight. And He did so in a more personal way than when He first created us in the beginning. As the verse goes on to say that God created us in Christ Jesus. Now what this means is that the way that God created us anew is by the life, death, burial, and resurrection of His glorious Son Jesus Christ. In Christ Jesus our God literally stepped into our world and became one of us and lived the perfect life for us that we couldn't and died in our place for us and then came up out of the grave to prove that He was the Son of God and that His death, on the cross was totally sufficient to save us and make us a new creation. God did it all to Him belongs to glory.

II. Second, as we seek to understand God's handiwork, let's notice the purpose of God's handiwork (vs 10)

Well the message of this verse is quite clear about why God has made us in His handiwork. It is so that we can do good works. "Created in Christ Jesus to do good works..."

Now it's important that we once again remind ourselves of the first point of the message and of the two other verses chosen for this message. The point being is that the works by which we are saved are not our works but God's works. We are his handiworks not ours. The two other verses make it quite clear. "For it is by grace you have been saved through faith and this is not from yourselves it is the gift of God - not by works so that no one can boast." (vs 8,9).

Therefore the good works that we are created to do are not for salvation but Rather are the results of our salvation. We are saved by God's work so that we can do good works for His glory and honor.

In the book of Philippians Paul once again gives us this principle "Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed—not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence—continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose." (Phil 2:12, 13) We work out what God works in us to accomplish His good purpose.

So if you have been saved then what we should be able to see happening in your life is that it is producing good works that God is working in you.

III. Third, as we seek to understand God's handiwork let's notice the preparation involved in God's handiwork (vs 10)

What this verse talks about is that the good works that God in Christ Jesus has created us to do where prepared by Him for us to do in the past. In other words in the eternal past when God through His foreknowledge chose us. He also chose for us what it is that He wanted us to do for His glory and honor. He chose what our spiritual gifts, talents, and works would be. Yes, it's sometimes hard to decipher what those things are. But we can never say as a Christian that there is nothing in particular that God has called or chosen for me to do. He absolutely has specific ministries or work that He wants us each to do. And some of those good works are ones that we all are called to do. They are the commands laid down by God for us all as Christians to do. We are all called to love one another and to care for one another and the list goes on.

However may we all be praying to God that He will help us to carry out those specific good works that He's planned in advance for us each to do. And really all that's required is that we always are willing and as louse as we are willing then it will come to us.

IV. Fourth, as we seek to understand God's handiwork, let's notice the plan of God's handiwork (vs 10)

Well this point will only take a few lines to reveal the plan of God's handiwork. It's the last phrase of the of the verse, "...which God prepared in advance <u>for us to do</u>." It's simply this that we are to do those good works. We are not to sit around and just merely discuss them but rather to do them. Are you doing them?

Conclusion:

I simply want to conclude by asking us can people tell that we are God's handiwork, His masterpiece because they can see His good works coming out of us?






