



# Evidence that got it wrong

John 19:16-37

Introduction: How was the crucifixion of Jesus Christ our Lord ever possible? For in many ways all of the evidences seem to conclude that it would be impossible for humanity to crucify the holy Son of God, and yet it happened. So in this message I want us to focus on this evidence that seems to conclude that Jesus Christ should have never been arrested tried, and crucified. It's the evidence that got it wrong,

I. The first evidence that says He shouldn't have been crucified was based upon who He was and in vs 19-22, and John 1:1, 14. Pilate, the Roman governor in Jerusalem, who eventually sentenced Jesus to be crucified, had a notice declaring Jesus to be the "King of the Jews" prepared and nailed to the cross Jesus was crucified on. This enraged the religious authorities who had pushed for Jesus' crucifixion. Because this, to the Jews was a statement that referred to Jesus to be their Messiah. For the King of the Jews had, by this time become a messianic phrase. So how in the world However, John begins his gospel with a powerful declaration about who Jesus, the King of the Jews really is. In his very first verse he declares that, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was God in the beginning" (John 1:1-2).

Then in the same chapter John tells us what the Word did. "The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the One and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth" (John 1:14).

We know that John is using the expression "the Word" as a reference to Jesus Christ our Lord. Thus Jesus has always been God, and He chose to step into the world of humanity by taking upon Himself flesh, becoming one of us and yet remain God as well.

All of the Gospels as well as all of the other New Testament authors are in agreement that Jesus was God in the flesh. So with this clear, factual evidence, how in the world could it be possible that Jesus could be crucified, and yet He was.

II. The second evidence that says He shouldn't have been crucified was based upon what He had done. John 20:30,31; 21:25. According to these verses we discover that Jesus had performed more miracles, signs and wonders than could be counted. As a matter of fact the miracles, signs and wonders which are being referred to in these particular verses, are ones that Jesus did that weren't recorded. John says that all of the unrecorded ones alone would require a library far larger than our world to contain the stories of those miracles, signs and wonders.

However the miracles, signs and wonders that Jesus did that are recorded, those alone would be enough to

that anyone who can heal the sick, give sight to a blind man, hearing to a deaf mute, walk on water, calm the storms, feed the masses with a few loaves of bread and fishes, cast out demons, and raise the dead, that no way could mankind put Jesus on the cross, yet they did.

As a matter of fact the disciples had just a few days before, witnessed Jesus resurrect Lazarus from the dead after he had lain in the grave for four days! Within the last 24 hours they watched Him attach an ear back upon the servant of the high priest which Peter had cut off with a sword. How is it possible that one who could perform so many powerful miracles be led to a cross and nailed to it?

III. The third evidence that says He shouldn't have been crucified is based upon what He had available to Him. Matthew (26:50-54). As Jesus was about to be led away by a cohort of soldiers, which usually consisted of 600 soldiers, plus all the rest of the crowd that came with them, the apostle Peter took out his sword and cut off one ear of the High Priests servant.

Now possibly Peter was thinking that once he drew out his sword and began swinging that Jesus would then join in and actually take over and finish off these soldiers and the crowd that came with them.

Instead however, Jesus did just the opposite. Instead of fighting, Jesus instructed Peter to put the sword away. He then compassionately and graciously put the ear back on the mans head. By doing this Jesus was letting the disciples know that He didn't need His disciples or their weapons to defend Him. For He had twelve legions of angels that He could have called upon His Father to release to His defense if He only asked. That equated to at least 72,000 angels standing by and ready to come at His beckoning. In the Old Testament, one angel alone took out 185,000 Assyrian soldiers. So just imagine what 72,000 could do.

Yet though the angelic soldiers were primed and ready, Jesus refused to call for their assistance. Instead He prayed to His Father in Heaven that His Fathers will be done not His own be done. (Matthew 26:39-42).

IV. The fourth evidence that says He shouldn't have been crucified was based on who was attempting to side with Him. (Luke 23:13-16) What we discover in this set of verses is that the political leaders that the Jews took Jesus to so they could condemn Jesus to be crucified were; Pilate, who was governor in Jerusalem, and Herod who was in charge of the Galilean section of Israel.

However, both of these political leaders seemingly did their best to convince the Jewish people to release Jesus and not crucify Him. Especially Pilate, who did so much within his ability, over and over, in attempt to let Jesus go.

Sadly, however the religious leaders, as well as the crowd refused to back down until they weakened the resolve of Pilate and got what they wanted which was to have Jesus crucified. So not even the actual wishes of the political leader could deter Calvary.

Conclusion: So in conclusion the question is, then why did not all of this above evidence mentioned prevent the crucifixion from taking place? Well Jesus answered that question this way; When He told His disciples that He could, if He so desired, call down the twelve legions of angels. "But how then would the Scriptures be fulfilled that say it must happen this way?" (Matthew 26:54) In other words it had to happen the way it did because that's the way the Scriptures in the Old Testament said it would happen, And that's exactly the way His Heavenly Father planned for it to happen.

So how did the Scripture prophecy that Jesus would accomplish the Fathers' will and bring about our redemption? Well we will read one chapter in the Old Testament to answer that question; Isaiah, chapter 53.

Who has believed our message and to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed? He grew up before him like a tender shoot, and like a root out of dry ground. He had no beauty or majesty to attract us to him, nothing in his appearance that we should desire him. He was despised and rejected by mankind, a man of suffering, and familiar with pain. Like one from whom people hide their faces, he was despised, and we held him in low esteem. Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; The punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed. We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth; He was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as sheep before its shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth. By oppression and judgment he was taken away. Yet who of his generation protested? For he was cut off from the land of the living; For the transgression of my people he was punished. He was assigned a grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death, Though he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth. Yet it was the Lord's will to crush him and cause him to suffer. and thought the Lord makes his life an offering for sin, he will see his offspring and prolong his days, and the will of the Lord will prosper in his hand. after he has suffered. he will see the light of life and be satisfied; By his knowledge my righteous servant will justify many, and he will bear their iniquities. Therefore I will give him a portion among the great, and he will divide the spoils with the strong, because he poured out his life unto death, and was numbered with the transgressors. For he bore the sin of many. and made the intercession for the transgressors.

The song called, "*He could have made 10,000 angels*", says it so clearly:

"They bound the hands of Jesus in the garden where He prayed. They led Him through the streets in shame. They spat upon the Savior so pure and free from sin. They said 'crucify Him, He's to blame!' Chorus: He could have called 10,000angels to destroy the world

and set Him free, He could have called 10,000 angels, but He died alone for you and me."

Upon His precious head they placed a crown of thorns. They laughed and said, "Behold the King ". They struck Him and they cursed Him and mocked His holy name. And all alone He suffered everything.

Chorus:

He could have called 10,000angels to destroy the world and set Him free, He could have called 10,000 angels, but He died alone for you and me."

There are more lines to the song but these give the picture of what my conclusion is about. Instead of using what was available to Him to destroy the world and set Him free, He used His power and authority to go to the cross to die for us all. It was the only way that He could save us. Praise be to our Blessed Lord that He did God 's way to provide for us, the way.


