

From the Pastor's desk:

#### **The Resurrection is the Greatest Remedy for Fear. Revelation 1:9-20**

**Introduction:** There's a very odd result that took place at the resurrection of our Lord. That odd result was that our Lord's resurrection created fear while at the same time it relieved fear.

To begin with, practically everyone involved with our Lord's resurrection, in one way or another experienced fear. The watch of Roman soldiers that had been assigned the responsibility of guarding the tomb, and a watch of soldiers referred to 100 soldiers, became like dead men when they saw the Angel of the Lord appear, and felt the earth shake, and saw the stone roll away. These hardened soldiers were the ones who appeared to be in the tomb, while Jesus was already up from the grave- alive forever more!

However, they were not only frightened from what they had seen but what they had discovered. And what they discovered was that the tomb was empty, the body of our Lord and Savior was missing. This was real bad news for them. For anytime a Roman soldier lost their prisoner their lives may be taken in exchange for the lost prisoner.

The women who first came to the tomb and the disciples a little later, were frightened because they didn't know where Jesus body had been moved to or who had moved it.

Th religious and political leaders that had pushed for Jesus

Crucifixion, and gave consent to it, were fearful. Not because they necessarily believed that He had risen, but because of what they conceived to be a deception to convince others that He had risen. Thus they created their own deception story, paying the soldiers off to convince them to say to others that Jesus' disciples came and stole the body away while all one hundred of the soldiers fell asleep.

So, as we see everyone involved in someway or another became fearful because of His resurrection. On the other, four of the greatest words that were spoken at the resurrection have relieved the fear of God's people more than any other ever spoken: Those words are "do not be afraid". These words were spoken to the women who came to the tomb as well as to Peter and John, who also came to the tomb. Jesus also spoke them to His disciples when He first appeared to them in the upper room, where they were hiding for fear of the people that had crucified Jesus.

Now why did those four words become the greatest remedy to remove fears? Well of course, it's words that were spoken immediately following those words. What were those words? "He's not here; He has risen, just as He said" (Matt. 28:6). If Death could not hold Him in the grave then there's nothing to fear.

Well six decades later the Apostle John, exiled on the island of Patmos for preaching the Word of God, became frightened out of his wits from a particular vision of Jesus that he saw. Then Jesus, once again said those four powerful and soothing words directly to John, "do not be afraid".

Now John had not only heard those four words spoken six decades earlier, at the tomb of our Lord, but also on another occasion before Jesus death, burial and resurrection. It happened on the mountain of transfiguration, where Jesus allowed His deity to shine through His humanity. James, Peter and John were with Jesus on this occasion. Also appearing on the scene were the Old Testament characters Moses and Elijah. This was such a mountain-top experience. But then God spoke out of the clouds Fell to ground, covering their eyes so that they wouldn't see God, because they believed by doing so they would be consumed.

However, God has stopped speaking, Moses and Elijah were gone and Jesus walked over and touched the disciples and told them to "get up", He said "don't be afraid". They got up and all they saw was Jesus. He's all we need to see to conquer our fears. And now that He arose from the dead He will always be there for us. So let's look at how Jesus' resurrection is the greatest remedy for fear.

**I. First the Resurrection of Jesus is the Greatest Remedy for fear because of who Jesus is, vs 17 & 18.** There is no one like Jesus, and never has been, and never will be. It's because of who He uniquely is that our fear and anxiety can all be made calm. Especially now, since He was resurrected. And this is exactly how He calmed down Johns fear by reminding him who He is.

There were two words that Jesus used to begin each description of who He was, and is; "I Am". Now, if Jesus had used those two words alone and added no description with them, they alone would be enough to let us know just who He is. He's the great "I Am" which is a term that covers all bases. But in order to help John understand how, who He is will remove his fear, is to give some specific answer to who He is.

First Jesus tells John that, "I am the first and the last." What Jesus meant by that was the there's never been anyone before Him and there will never be anyone greater than He is, ever, in all eternity. He's the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and end. Second He said, "I and the Living One; I was dead and now look, I am alive for ever and ever!" Look John, Jesus is saying to him, you saw me six decades ago in all of my resurrected glory, and nothing has changed. I am still alive and will be forever and ever because at the resurrection death had lost it's complete hold on me. For death could not, and cannot and never will defeat or conquer the eternal Son of God. It was the humanity of Jesus that died but since you can't kill the deity of Jesus, His deity gave back to His humanity, a new glorified body that came out of the grave! Amen! We must not look to frail human beings as our primary source of overcoming our fears. Rather we must look to the one who overcame death to reveal to us that we can forever more rest in Him who is alive for ever more- Amen.

**II. Second, the Resurrection of Jesus is the Greatest Remedy for fear because of what Jesus holds, vs 18.** He told John that, "I hold the keys of death and Hades." Hades is a reference to the place of the dead. Now keys have always been a symbol of Authority. If you have a set of keys to something it usually means that you are the owner or at least an important part of the place or thing the keys go to. Therefore this ownership gives you authority over whatever the keys belong to.

Well, because Jesus conquered death He thus holds the key or, if you would, authority over death and Hades. He has ownership over the place. Therefore He alone has the power to bring people up out of the grave and the power to send them to Hell, a place He desires no one to go to, and because He conquered the grave they don't have to, if only they will trust Him as Lord and Savior.

The Apostle Paul says it all when he said.

"Where, o death, is your victory? Where o death, is your sting?" The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters stand firm.

Let nothing move you. Always give yourself fully to the work of the Lord because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in

vain. (I Cor. 15:55-58 NIV)

**III. Third, the Resurrection of Jesus is the greatest Remedy for fear because of where Jesus is, vs 12, 13, 19, 20.** When John first saw the vision of Jesus in this chapter he observed that Jesus was standing in the midst of seven golden lamp stands and is holding seven stars. Jesus then, a little later, explains to John who the lamp stands and stars represent. "The mystery of the seven stars and of the seven golden lamp stands is this: The seven stars Are the angels of the seven churches and the seven lamp stands are the seven churches". (vs 20)

So Jesus is saying to John, you need not fear John because I stand in the midst of my churches and I hold their spiritual leaders in my right hand. Jesus si saying that He will never walk away from His church until He returns to take her out of this world. He has always been in their midst and He will always hold on to their pastors to give them the strength and wisdom to carry out His work in the world.

<u>**Conclusion:**</u> So as I leave this church soon because of my retirement, I know that this church is going to be just fine because our Lord and Master, Savior and King stands in her midst fulfilling His words to Peter some six decades earlier, "And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church and the gates of Hades will not over come it". (Matt 16:18)

I also know that my blessed Lord holds me in His hands and I know that I've got nothing either to worry about.

Dear friend cling to the one who conquered death and let Him give you victory over death, hell, and the grave as well as all of your fears.


