

A Mother Who Made it into The Bible Hall of Fame of Faith

Exodus 2:1-10, Acts 7:20-22, Hebrews 11:23-26 Introduction: There's a 'hall of fame' for practically every area of our lives. From sports to entertainment to art, and music, and so on, the heroes, or great performers of these various areas have their names inducted into their particular hall of fame.

Well in the Bible we discover that there is a chapter that contains a list of these whose names are recorded and inducted into the Great Hall of Fame of Faith. It's a list of men and women found in the Old Testament who expressed an exuberant amount of faith. In that list we fine a mother and a dad whose names are not mentioned. However, their son's name is and his name is Moses. From other scripture text (Ex.6:20)we know that their names are Amram and Jochebed.

Now though Jochebed, the mother of Moses, doesn't have her name mentioned in the hall of fame of faith, she's mentioned as Moses mother because of the things she did for her son that helped him to become a great man of faith himself.

Let's examine the things that Moses' mother, Jochebed, did that caused her to be listed in the great hall of fame of faith, and then let's pray that we too can do the kind of things to our children like Jochebed did to Moses that might make it possible for us to get our name in the great hall of fame of faith.

I. First of all, let's notice that Jochebed made it into the great hall of fame of faith because of her perception. Ex. 2:2 and Heb.11:23.

In all three of the scripture references used for this message we clearly see that Moses' mother and father perceived that Moses was a fine child, a beautiful child, and a special child. They saw him as a gift from God. A gift that's worthy of living. A gift worthy of loving and caring for. A gift worthy of their utmost attention and protection. They understood that he was a human being created in the image of God and therefore it was their responsibility to do all they could to give their son the gift of living.

Now the question we need to ask ourselves is, how do we perceive our children? When we look at them do we see them as gifts from God; as human beings created in the image of God who is worthy of your attention and devotion? Or do we merely see them as a nuisance, someone who is interfering with your agenda? May we learn from Jochebed to see our children the way God wants us to and then from that perception do all the right things for them to help them become people of faith.

II. Second of all let's notice that Jochebed made it into the great hall of fame of faith because of her protection, Ex. 2:2-10; Acts 7:20-21; Heb.11:23.

In all three of our scripture references that we are using we see that because Jochebed perceived that her son, Moses was a gift from God. He was therefore worthy of all of the protection that she and her husband, Amram could provide for him. And with every ounce of wisdom and strength they had they did everything humanly possible that they could to hide and protect their son.

However, all of their human efforts were not enough to give Moses full and complete protection. For as he grew it became more difficult to hide him, and besides he had

become louder, and therefore impossible to cover the loud cries and screams that he was making. Therefore different measures were required that were beyond their human abilities. And it turns our that Jochebed knew just where to turn to find that help and protection that would take care of her son which was beyond her ability.

So the question is, where did she turn to, and this is where her faith shines through the most? Well the obvious answer is that Jochebed placed her son Moses into the arms and hands of our blessed Lord Jesus Christ. And the question rings back, 'where does it tell us that'? Well it doesn't exactly say that, but her actions demonstrate that.

So how do her actions demonstrate that Jochebed placed her son Moses into the arms and hands of our Lord Jesus Christ, thus demonstrating faith? Well once she could no longer hide him, she built a floating basket by taking a basket coated with tar and pitch, thus waterproofing it. She then laid her son Moses in it, knowing that he was safe from drowning, and placed him in the very river that Pharaoh had commanded that the Israelites throw their infant sons to drown them, to curb the rapid growth of the Jewish population. By doing this she was entrusting the care of her son to the only one she know could truly protect him.

Jochebed had a similar example from the past to draw from. That example was the example of what God did with Noah and his family, when He sent the world-wide flood to judge the earth. He told Noah and his sons to build the ark and when it was time for the flood to come God instructed Noah and his family to get in the ark, along with the animals. God then shut them in the ark where they were safe from the flood waters. In the ark they were safe for God was protecting them.

In like manner Moses was safe in his arc of bulrushes, for God too was watching over him while he floated in that basket. God made sure that the basket would drift right where Pharaoh's daughter bathed and He

Also made sure that the baby Moses would cry out at the right moment to stir up the heart and emotion of Pharaoh's daughter, thus making her feel tender towards Moses. God also placed Moses' sister, Miriam at the right spot at the right moment, to ask Pharaoh's daughter if she would like for her to fine someone to care for the baby. Of course this resulted in Jochebed getting to take care of her son for while longer.

So, once again Jochebed knew that the only hope for her son was to place him in the arms and hands of our Lord Jesus Christ. This is what we must do with our children. We do all that we humanly, possibly can to protect them and take care of them. But then we must realize that that's never enough. We too must place them in the ark of safety, in the arms of Jesus. That's where our faith must rest, in the arms and hands of Jesus.

III. Third of all, let's notice that Jochebed made it into the great hall of fame of faith because of her provisions Ex. 2:2-10; Heb. 11:23-26.

Now in this point I'm referring to the provisions that she provided for son Moses. Once Moses' sister, Miriam got Moses back from Pharaoh's daughter, she brought him back to Jochebed and Jochebed nursed him. For how long we are not sure, but long enough for him to have grown up for a while.

But not only did she provide the physical substances required for Moses, but it's very evident that she also gave him spiritual food as well. The reason I know this is because we are told that Moses later on, though raised up in the teaching of the Egyptians, chose to reject their ways and instead choose the way of his true family, the Israelites. And I'm fully convinced that Jochebed and Amram used every moment they had with Moses to instruct him in the ways of our Lord.

If we are going to be listed in the great hall of fame of faith, then we must care for our children enough to

provide both physical and spiritual food for them.

<u>Conclusion:</u> Will we perceive our children as gifts from God, worthy of our affection and devotion and attention, doing all that we can to protect them, primarily by continually placing them in the arms of Jesus? And will we, both physically and spiritually, provide for them? If so we may yet find our names in the great hall of fame of faith.


