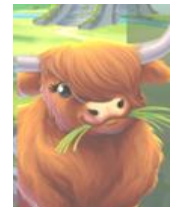

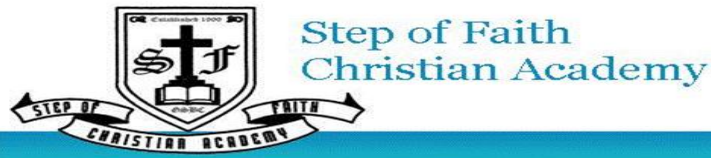

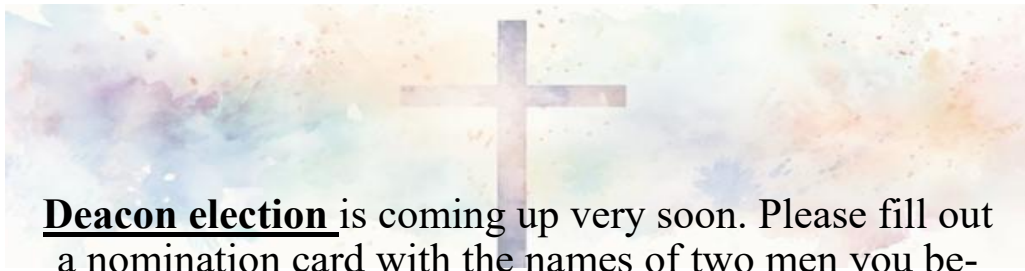

Deacon election is coming up very soon. Please fill out a nomination card with the names of two men you believe are biblically qualified, and place it in the offering or in the designated box in the foyer. This is not a vote, but a nomination for the important service of Deacon.

Acts 6:2-4 *So the twelve summoned the congregation of the disciples and said, "It is not desirable for us to neglect the word of God in order to serve tables .³ Instead, brothers and sisters, select from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we may put in charge of this task.⁴ But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word."*

1 Timothy 3:8-15 *⁸ Deacons likewise must be men of dignity, not insincere, not prone to drink much wine, not greedy for money,⁹ but holding to the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience.¹⁰ These men must also first be tested; then have them serve as deacons if they are beyond reproach.¹¹ Women must likewise be dignified, not malicious gossips, but temperate, faithful in all things.¹² Deacons must be husbands of one wife, and good managers of their children and their own households.¹³ For those who have served well as deacons obtain for themselves a high standing and great confidence in the faith that is in Christ Jesus.¹⁴ I am writing these things to you, hoping to come to you before long;¹⁵ but in case I am delayed, I write so that you will know how one should act in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and support of the truth.*

There are more scriptures about the service and requirements for Deacons in the New Testament - check it out, and see who God may put on your heart to nominate.
