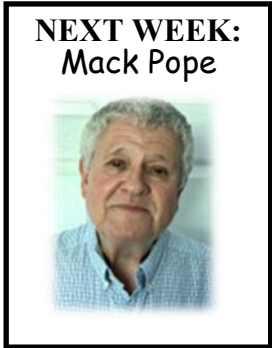

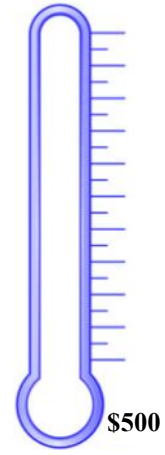
Church/ School Campus Sidewalk Campaign
